Curriculum, Instruction & Assessment (CI&A)

- Summer learning opportunities are posted, including:

- Has a <u>service</u> for next year that will support implementation of the Expeditionary Learning modules
 - Integrated professional development and resources approach
 - o Initial overview session

 - Student and teacher text
 - Class sets of handouts
 - \$1500/teacher for year one; \$1000/teacher for subsequent years at same grade level
 - Materials- printing and texts at OCM BOCES cost
- PBL^{NY} demonstration site project
 - 16-24 Teachers receive 3 days of PBL 101 in the summer of 2013 (OCM BOCES' Common Core PBL), including training materials
 - Teachers will collaboratively develop a Common Core PBL unit for 2013
 - Teachers will collaboratively develop a Common Core PBL unit for spring 2014
 - Teachers will receive ½ day release time per month for planning purposes (and/or to meet with PBLNY coach)
 - Coaching for any additional units
 - Units will be with other PBLNY schools, in person and on-line archive
 - PBLNY coach will spend one day per week in the school building assisting teachers with their projects, offering resources for projects and helping with the implementation of projects.
 - The cost of one year is \$28,000 dollars, based on 40 days at \$700 per day custom, on-site rate (can be done at a half-level with 20 days for \$14,000)

 - We had a quick tour of the entire WCNY facility from Bob Daino, WCNY president and CEO.
 - We spent time in the Enterprise America construction area discussing the curriculum, logistics, etc.
