Committee Review

- Regional scoring required next year, recommended now
- Regents regional scoring also required next year
- No one with a vested interest in a test can score it
- BOCES involvement might help insert a level of impartiality to the process
- Interest in using school improvement COSER as much as possible

Potential Tri-Part Regional Scoring

- We continue to press forward with a serious consideration of a form of regional scoring that would be facilitated by OCM BOCES:
 - BOCES organizes some logistics
 - BOCES staff as the site coordinator at each of the three locations (west side, Central, Southside (actual locations to be determined))
 - Common training for trainers, but use existing skilled and experience trainers from previous years and locations (scheduled for April 4th, 3:30-5:30pm)
 - Common directions for table leaders (but not necessarily live training)
 - RIC runners at each location to take papers straight to the RIC
- We will gather data from all districts using an electronic survey. We will ask for information about:
 - Interest
 - Number of papers at each grade
 - Number of scores used at each grade last year
 - Amount of clerical staff employed
 - Whether a district has space for scoring (and the capacity)
 - For which tests districts have an experienced trainer
- We will ask the RIC if there is the ability to suppress the district/school name on the answer sheet
- Our **next meeting will be 3:00pm, December 8th, Center Conference Room following the PBL Administrative Overview from the Buck Institute** At this meeting we will take a look at the data collected from the survey.
