- The next <u>NTnews</u> was distributed in advance of the Next Generation science standards draft release.
- The Science Center will realign all units, update materials, emphasize content reading and writing, and infuse Discovery learning resources. The Center will also transition to becoming a STEM Center.
- APPR update
  - The <u>SLO Bank</u> now includes more than seventy examples of SLOs. These are examples, not exemplars.
  - APPR changes:
    - VAM for 2012-2013 for 4-8 ELA and math (that means 25/15 for those teachers).
    - SLOs cannot be used within the locally-selected measures subcomponent for a teacher in any grade or subject where there is a growth or value-added model. Use LAT!
    - If all 60% for principals is derived from the broad leadership assessment, ISLLC/rubric, then the 2/3 sources is not necessary. The 2/3 sources of evidence rule only applies when you are assigning separate points for goals.
    - It looks like high school principals will have VAM based on Regents scores next year (and not graduation rates).
