High School Math Lesson - First Five Minutes of Class Focusing on NYS Teaching Standard Four: **Learning Environment**

Students are seated in rows.
Poster at front of room has prompts for the question.
The question of the day was posted on front white board.
Posters were around the room which explained procedures such as summarizing.
Rules were posted at front of room.
Teacher stood by white board in front of room.
Teacher said look at this question I want you to predict the height of the ceiling.
Teacher told students to get out a piece of paper and told students to get a piece from another student if they did not have one.
Teacher said you don't have to write the question out on your paper despite the prediction.
Teacher repeated direction to predict the height of the floor to ceiling four times.
Teacher walked back and forth at front of room during first five minutes of class.
Teacher told students to pair themselves up on their own.
Each student was told to be either number one or number two of the pair.
Two students stood at back and side of room. One student faced white board; one student was turned away.
Three students raised hand indicating they predicted a 15 foot high ceiling.
Three students raised hand and indicating they predicted a 10 foot high ceiling.
Teacher asked class how they came up with their prediction.
Two students raised their hand volunteering to answer to explain their predictions.
Teacher called on student by name to give prediction method within one second.
