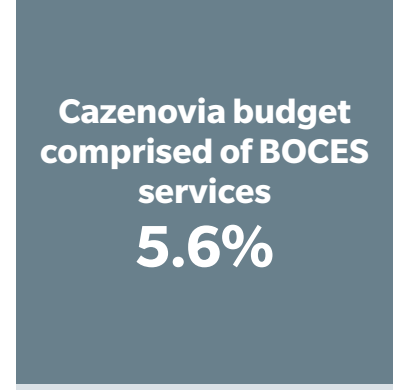

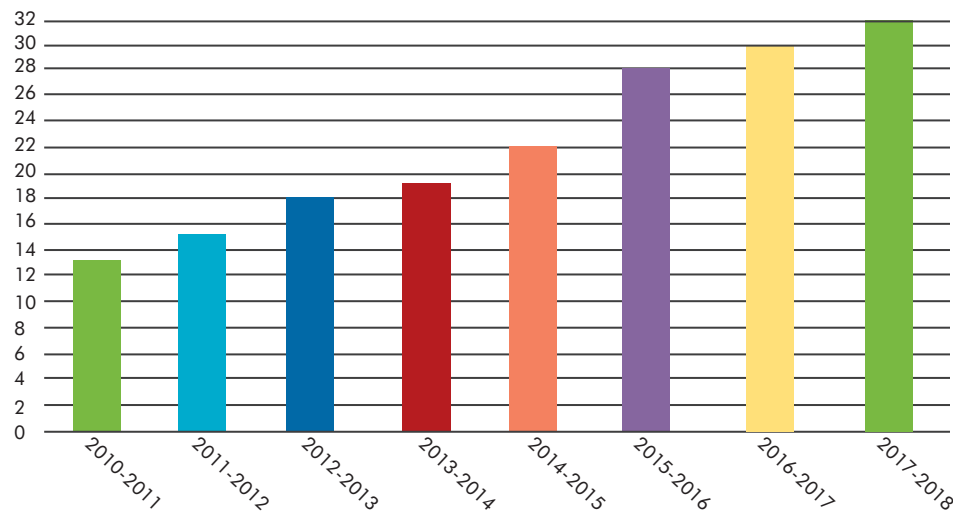
CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to real-world situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of 33 national innovative programs.

In 2017, nearly 400 seniors from OCM BOCES' component districts were eligible to earn CTE endorsements on their high school diplomas, including Christopher Beare, Erisawe Briere, Kacie Burdin, Brennah Caffrey, Maleigha Ellithorpe, Timothy Harken, Jacob Kopylczak, Hope McGee, Alfred Moskvich, Alexa Nekritz and Devon Young from the Cazenovia Central School District.

Devin Shon has always excelled at maintaining and restoring cars, a passion that has flourished since he first started tinkering with vehicles at the age of six. Now the senior at Cazenovia High School is learning about computer control systems, diagnostic strategies and electrical system function in the OCM BOCES Automotive Technology Program at Driver's Village, the automobile mega-center in Cicero. This OCM BOCES embedded program offers rigorous coursework with hands-on experience that has already resulted in a part-time job for Devin at the center's Chevrolet dealership.

Devin says he especially likes the OCM BOCES Career & Technical Education program because it is not for the casual car enthusiast. The depth and breadth of the curriculum has taken him to "the next level" in terms of his automotive expertise, he said. He thinks students interested in the program would especially like the rotating internships that are offered at a variety of dealerships on-site.

"This isn't easy. This is hard. We do a lot of work here," Devin said. "But now I can answer much more in-depth questions than I used to be able to."

His instructor, Erick Dodge, said Devin has gained a huge amount of knowledge about complex automotive technology, but he has also developed interpersonal skills that will benefit him greatly in his pursuit of a college education and a career in the automotive field.

"Devin has learned how to act with professionalism when working with student peers, with industry technicians, managers and customers," Dodge said.

Next year, Devin hopes to study automotive technology at SUNY Morrisville. He thinks the OCM BOCES program at Driver's Village gave him an excellent head-start, especially since it also exposed him to a part-time job that allows him to gain relevant experience — and income — towards that goal.

DID YOU KNOW?

Cazenovia has six teachers in the 100Kin10 grant we have with the Smithsonian Science Education Center. The team has planned for their research lesson to be on April 6th so that the entire staff can participate as observers. This will provide a shared learning experience for the entire staff related to the new science standards and associated science curriculum materials. The lesson study team has demonstrated being instructional leaders though placing their own learning front and center to share with their colleagues.
