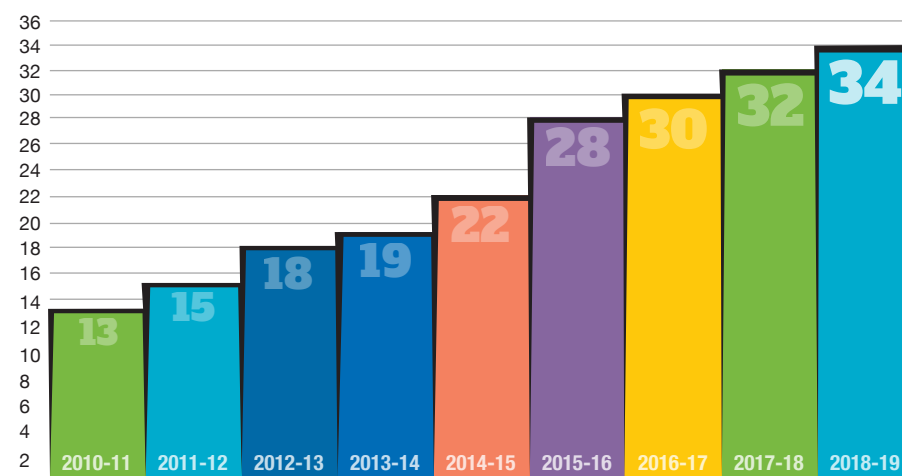
## Career & Technical Education

New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to real-world situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of more than 30 national innovative programs.

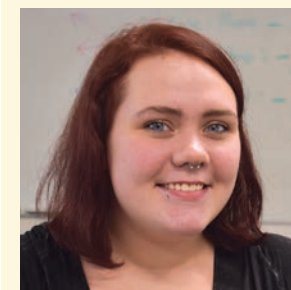
Number of classrooms in school district buildings that host BOCES Special Education Programs

## OCM BOCES & Cincinnatus = Student Success



Now that Phoenix Rice is a senior at Seven Valleys New Tech Academy, she appreciates the confidence she feels in her interactions with her peers, facilitators and other staff. Those interactions, in turn, have helped her become much more self-assured as she heads to college next year for a career in nursing.

"Phoenix is not afraid to verbalize her thoughts and does so with wit and intelligence," said one of her facilitators, Thomas Beasley. "She is willing to work with anyone, and she is confident without being arrogant."

Phoenix attributes much of her growth to the small, close-knit environment of Seven Valleys. She also believes the school has given her excellent real-life skills, especially when it comes to working in groups and collaborating with others on projects that are tied to real-world challenges. At the same time, she appreciates the academic rigor that Seven Valleys has provided to prepare her for her dream career.

Chemistry is her favorite subject, she says, largely because it is a prerequisite for nearly any kind of quality nursing program.

Beyond her achievements, facilitators at Seven Valleys have offered enthusiastic praise for Phoenix because of the positive atmosphere she brings to the classroom on a daily basis, as well as her thoughtfulness in always considering what is best for all students at the school.

"Phoenix works to make school a better place," Facilitator Jeffrey Clark said. "She is supportive of staff and students and always leads when given the opportunity."

## Did You Know?

Special education providers have been working with the OCM BOCES Special Education School Improvement Specialist in order to hone their skills so that they can better support their students. Most have attended professional development and have taken part in the coaching process in order to write better, standards-aligned, individual educational programs (IEPs) for their students and to provide the specially designed instruction each student needs to receive in order to be successful on those goals. They are fine-tuning their progress monitoring tools and gathering data on their students' growth towards these goals. The students' individual data help teachers refine their instructional approaches and do what needs to be done in order to meet their students' needs. Teachers are finding that they have gotten to know their students better in the process. They are able to articulate the students' strengths, their growth on goals, and areas of continued struggle more fluently with other staff members, parents, and with the students.
