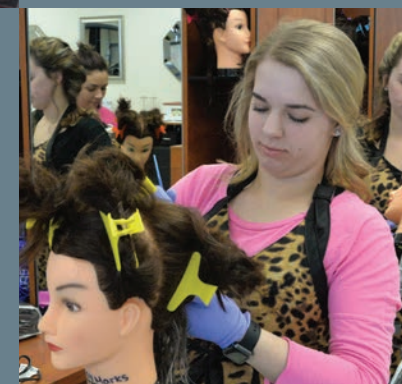

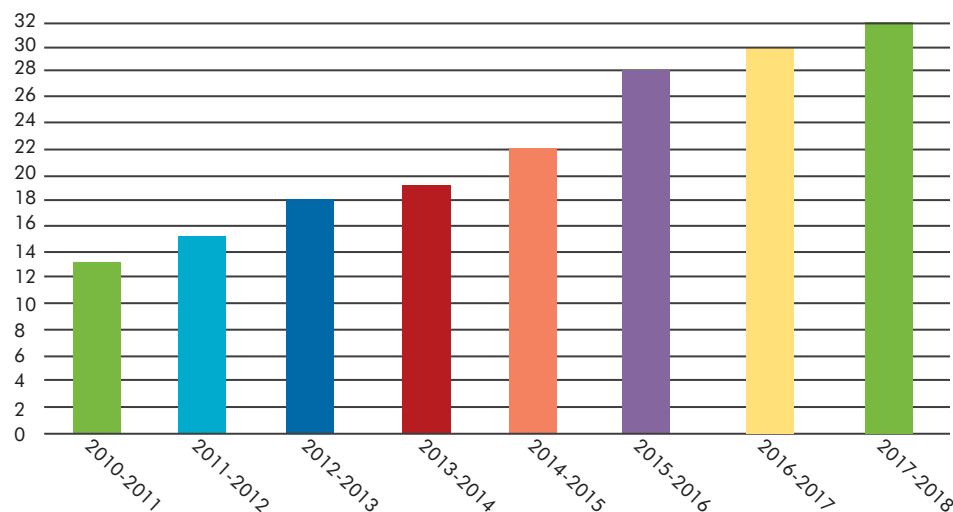
CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to real-world situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of 33 national innovative programs.

In 2017, nearly 400 seniors from OCM BOCES' component districts were eligible to earn CTE endorsements on their high school diplomas, including Elizabeth Brenchley, Kolton Brown, Rachel Cass, Emily Cortright, Ashlie Ervin, Samantha Marshall, Cody Metcalf, Dylan Nechwedowich, Meranda Palmer, Vick Rice, Garett Sudbrink, Kiersten Thompson and Antonio Totten from the Cincinnatus Central School District.

The program collates demographic and peer data for school districts across New York State and allows districts to access that information for the purpose of developing future-focused strategies to manage their limited resources and achieve improving academic success in today's challenging budget environment.

Cincinnatus sophomore Chloe Zeeuw has truly embraced the concept of "agency," or taking charge of her own learning, at Seven Valleys New Tech Academy in Cortland. Chloe routinely uses the Echo computer platform to check her grades and text herself reminders about assignments. A former introvert, she now feels confident reaching out to her facilitators, or teachers, about problems or concerns with her learning. In fact, Chloe says the self-directed Echo program and the professional, welcoming relationship she has with her facilitators represent her two favorite features of the OCM BOCES New Tech school.

Kim Wright, one of her facilitators, agrees.

"Chloe has made great strides in building her agency skills over the last year and a half," said Wright, who teaches a subject called GlobalLit. "She takes pride in her work and understands that she is in the driver's seat of her own learning."

Seven Valleys Principal Joanne Keim says Chloe has emerged as a true leader at the school and has made huge strides in reducing her anxiety about public speaking, which Chloe does routinely. Chloe also likes to problem-solve quickly and brings a "creative lens" to her academics that helps her process her learning, Wright said.

Her classmates admire her ability to stay on task.

"Chloe is one of the best classmates I've worked with at Seven Valleys since she makes sure everything gets done," said Heather Decker, a sophomore from Cortland. "She has a great handle on teamwork."

Looking ahead, Chloe hopes to attend college so she can study criminal psychology and pursue a job in the criminal justice field.

DID YOU KNOW?

Kristen Purcell, an OCM BOCES teacher trainer, is spending half her time this year in Cincinnatus, working as the district's curriculum coordinator. Her work has mostly been focused on leading elementary grade-level teams to review and document their ELA curriculum units to support equitable access to the standards for all kids. In addition to meeting regularly with teachers, she also serves as a member of the district's leadership team, meeting and collaborating with other district leaders, to share the progress of grade-level teams, review data, discuss district initiatives, and analyze student outcomes. The level of support offered by Kristen is pushing teachers to be more collaborative and reflective and will help improve student achievement.
