

They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area

businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of 33 national innovative programs.

Cortland sophomore Megan Porter says the overall environment at Seven Valleys New Tech Academy offers a perfect fit for her, from the smaller class sizes to the emphasis on Project Based Learning to the welcoming atmosphere. She feels safe, confident and accepted – feelings that translate into excellent and consistent academic work, according to her social studies facilitator, Kim Wright.

"Megan is a truly engaged learner," Wright said. "She works well with her peers and seeks feedback from facilitators. She contributes to the classroom. She is truly a valued member of our school."

Megan says she used to be a quiet student before the atmosphere at Seven Valleys gave her "a voice" and a newfound passion for learning. She credits student-created school norms for helping her feel respected and appreciated. She no longer feels shy in group work because "there's a lot of support and encouragement for each other," she said.

She also feels more engaged in her work, citing a recent Algebra assignment that had students collect and create their own data sets instead of using pre-existing ones. That, in and of itself, made the assignment more interesting, she said. She also enjoys the school's emphasis on forging partnerships with community groups and businesses, citing a recent "Tolerance Project" that included a visit from a representative of an LGBT community center.

"When I got here and saw how welcoming everyone was, I felt accepted – like this was the place for me," Megan said.

### DID YOU KNOW?

Cortland Enlarged City School District is partnering with OCM BOCES Special Education School Improvement Specialists (SE-SIS) to examine instructional programming and supports available to K-12 students with disabilities. This year's partnership is focused at Cortland Junior/Senior High School, where SE-SIS and administration have begun collecting classroom walk-through data to analyze instructional practices and assess current programming. The team is excited to partner together as they continue to develop an action plan to maximize achievement for all students.
