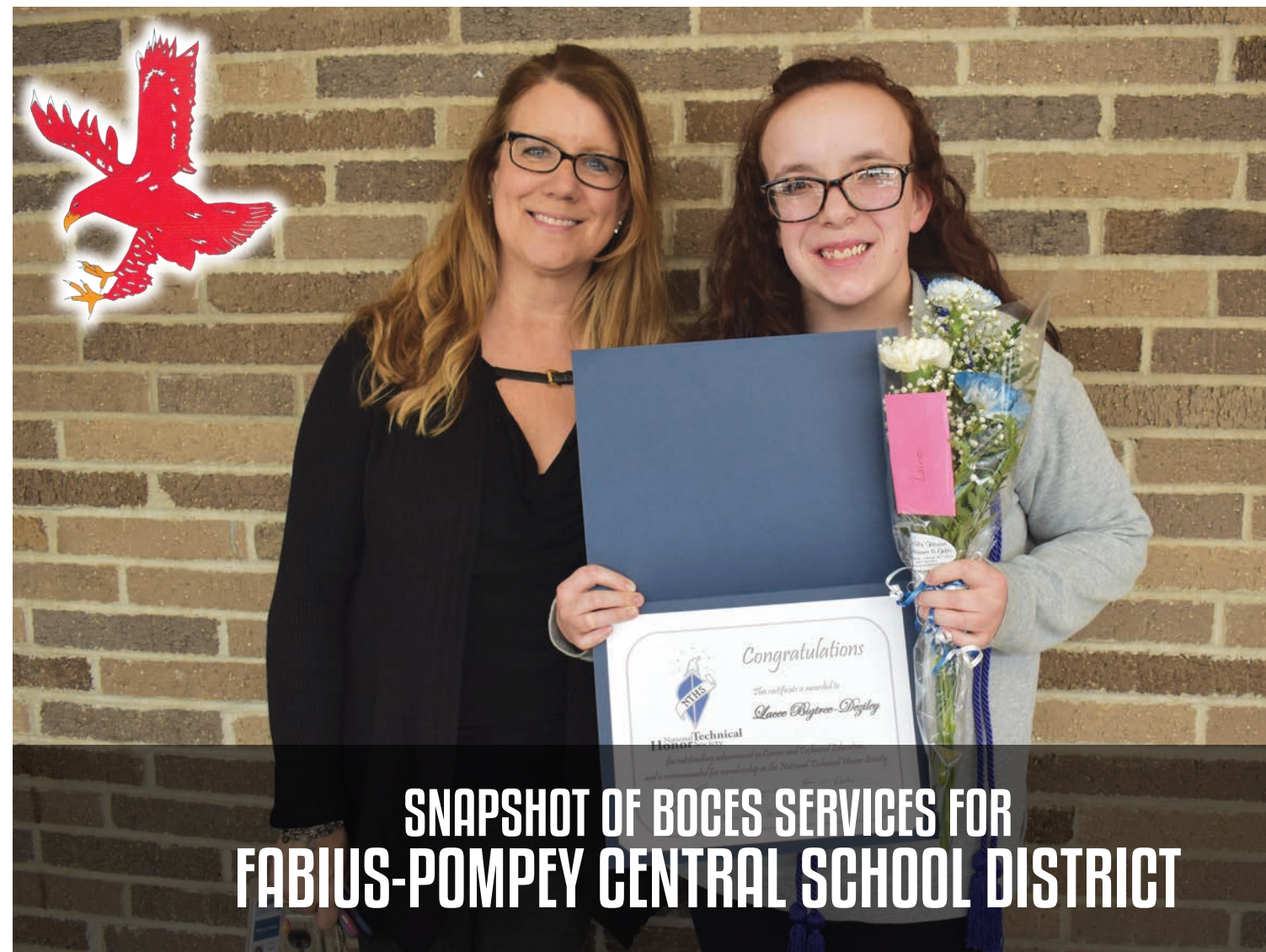

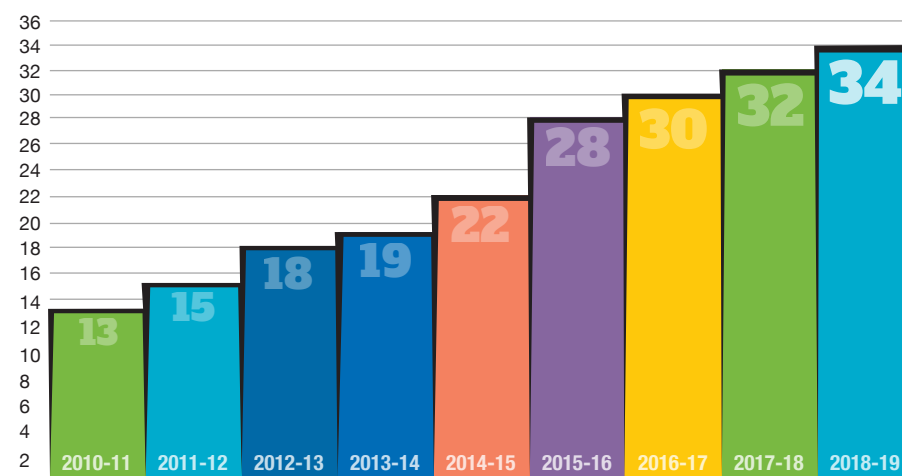
## Career & Technical Education

New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to real-world situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of more than 30 national innovative programs.

In 2018, nearly 300 seniors from OCM BOCES' component districts were eligible to earn CTE endorsements on their high school diplomas, including Fabius-Pompey students Lacey Bigtree-Deziley, Lauren Burton, Cody Elmer, Schuyler Gathmann, Mykel Grinnell, Erica Pilcher, Jacob Reinhard, Jordon Scutt and Brendan Wertz.

## OCM BOCES & Fabius-Pompey = Student Success



Senior Kaleigh Chartrand works with preschool children every day in the Head Start program through the Cortland County Community Action Program (CAPCO). As part of the OCM BOCES Early Childhood Education Program, Kaleigh and other students spend half of their school day immersed in the preschool, where they are responsible for planning and preparing educational activities for the children and learning about all aspects of the program's operations.

Her instructor, Heather Tuttle, says Kaleigh has been a great fit for the program.

"Through Kaleigh's time in the class, I have seen her blossom," Tuttle said. "She has become more outgoing with her peers. She has found her passion working with young children. Her enthusiasm is contagious."

For Kaleigh, the program has exposed her to a field she loves and hopes to pursue after high school. Because she enjoys what she is doing every day, she says she has become more focused on her classwork and determined to be successful.

"BOCES has helped me focus and concentrate," she said. "I have also been able to connect with more people and learn more about childhood education. It has definitely furthered my interest in this area."

One of the CAPCO Head Start teachers, Stephanie Lyon, says Kaleigh is a natural.

"She is a pleasure to have in the preschool," Lyon said. "The children really enjoy interacting with her."

## Did You Know?

Fabius-Pompey is continuing the implementation of the new elementary science curriculum materials program aligned to the new New York State Science Learning Standards. Teachers are engaging in two days of just-in-time professional development focused on the standards and the specific units, which were designed by the Smithsonian Science Education Center. The first new units introduced at each grade level focus on real-world, engineering-related issues. Fifth-graders, for example, tackle the question, "How do you get water to those in need?"
