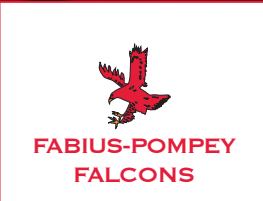

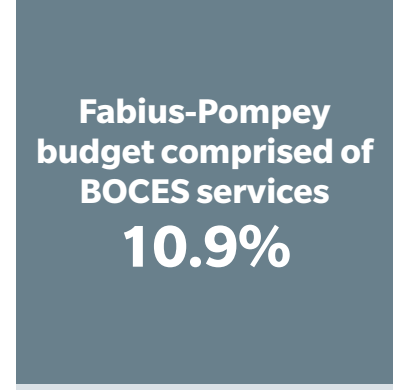

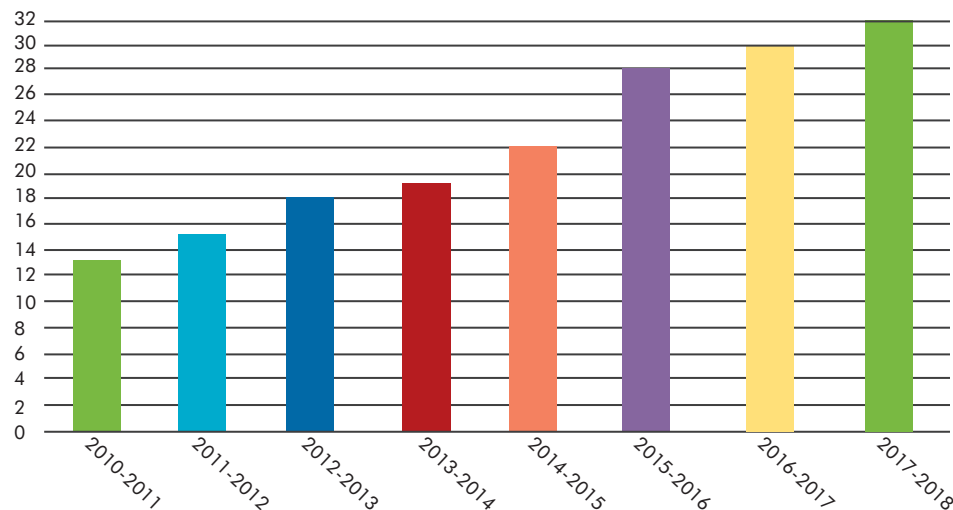
CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to real-world situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of 33 national innovative programs.

In 2017, nearly 400 seniors from OCM BOCES' component districts were eligible to earn CTE endorsements on their high school diplomas, including Jeffrey Ashley, Austin Chapman, Darienn Clark, Anna Denhoff, Jamie Fredenburg, Bradley Griffin, Morgan Hill, Kory Mawson, Hannah McMichael, Jerad Montague, Bradley Morgan, Kevin Niles, Owen Riehlman, Zachary Rybak, Brittany Shatraw and Connor Wisowaty from the Fabius-Pompey Central School District.

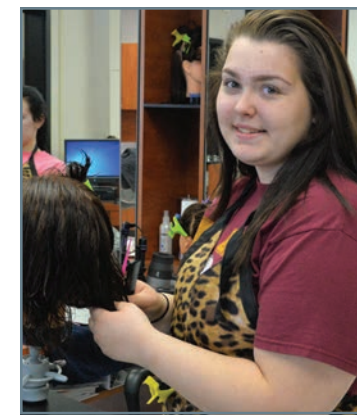

OCM BOCES purchased the **Forecast5** analytics software for all 23 component districts on a trial basis for the next two years. The program collates demographic and peer data for school districts across New York State and allows districts to access that information for the purpose of developing future-focused strategies to manage their limited resources and achieve improving academic success in today's challenging budget environment.

Since Erica Pilcher joined the OCM BOCES Cosmetology program last year, the Fabius-Pompey senior has thrived in her pursuit of industry-specific skills — skills that will support her long-term dream of owning a salon franchise and launching a hair-and-makeup business for movies and videos.

"I love to create beauty and make people feel better about themselves," she said.

In addition to improving her cosmetology skills, Erica believes her social skills, communication skills and leadership skills have soared since joining the Career & Technical Education program at the OCM BOCES Cortlandville Campus. This year, her classmates appointed her to serve as vice president of the SkillsUSA Club at McEvoy. Erica has already created and proposed a building-wide fundraiser to support the organization this spring.

"Erica is a student who strives for more learning every day," said her cosmetology instructor, Nicole Hadsell. "This creates an exciting learning environment for her and for myself as a teacher."

One classmate, Tully senior Shelby Cox, describes Erica as "the happy" of the salon. Erica herself says she enjoys coming to OCM BOCES every day so she can express her creativity through her talent and her trade. She loves meeting new people outside her home district who share her passion.

This fall, Erica plans to attend Alfred State to major in business. The program at OCM BOCES, she said, has given her a head-start for college and, ultimately, her career.

"I am learning every skill my industry requires so I can be successful," she said.

DID YOU KNOW?

OCM BOCES' Alcohol and Drug Abuse Prevention Education Program (ADA PEP) uses the expertise of Dan Piorkowski in delivering Evidenced Based Prevention (EBP) education to middle and high school students. Project Success is an EBP that works with large groups of students for Universal Prevention and a small group of students who need more expertise. Finally, one-on-one counseling is provided for students who need extra support. One aspect of the ADA PEP program is gathering data to help inform practice. Fabius-Pompey participated in the PRIDE survey with the 7th, 9th, and 11th graders. These results can be analyzed to help the district target areas of concern.
