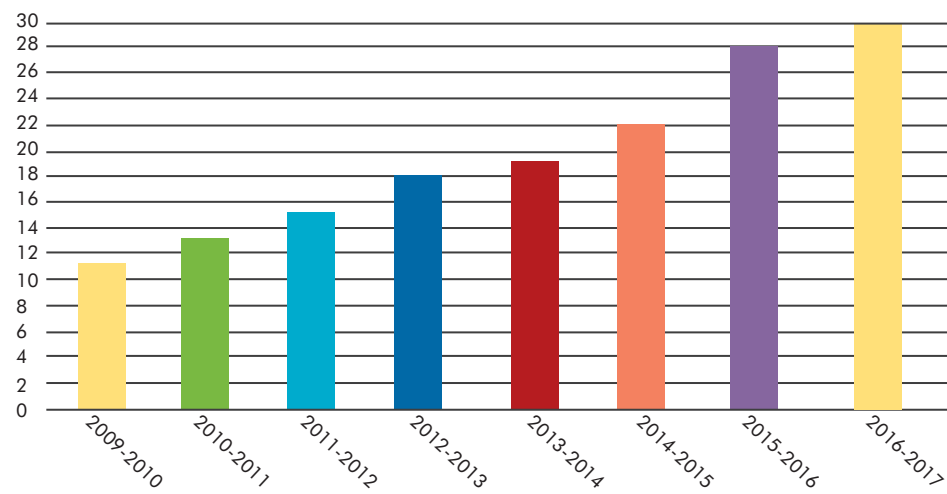
CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to real-world situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of 33 national innovative programs.

In 2016, more than 300 seniors from OCM BOCES' component districts were eligible to earn CTE endorsements on their high school diplomas, including Makala Bray, Aryanna Dee, Anna Demmon, Kashawna Graham, Cassandra Jordan, Scott Loucks, Courtney Mantor and Shavez Roberts from the Jamesville-DeWitt Central School District.

Cheyenne Brebeck (pictured left) knows firsthand about the important role that physical therapists and physical therapy assistants can play in a young person's life. Cheyenne, a high school junior from the Jamesville-DeWitt Central School District, has been an athlete for many years, participating in both competitive cheerleading and high school softball. But when a dislocated shoulder and two ACL tears interfered with her athletic endeavors at various times, Cheyenne found help **and** her career focus in physical therapy.

Cheyenne intends to become a physical therapist assistant so that she can help other athletes overcome injuries like the ones she suffered. Her goal is to eventually be part of the Los Angeles Rams Sports Medicine team, something that will require extensive study.

The high school junior knows that she is on her way to her goal though the OCM BOCES Physical Therapy program. She says, "It's great to get a sense of a college class and especially to get a head start. I know I have a lot of schooling ahead of me but I love that now I'm ahead of the competition because of this class."
