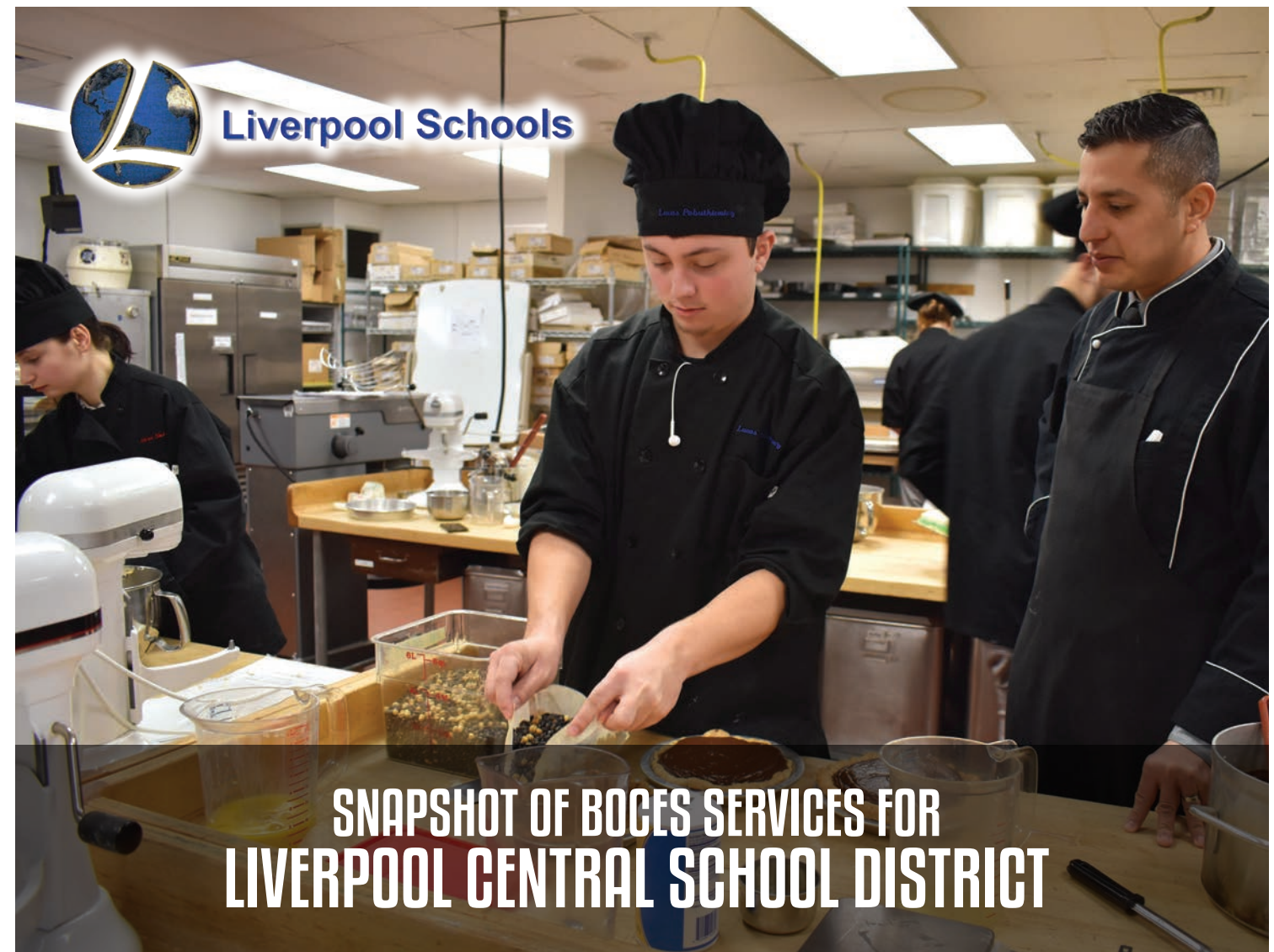

## SNAPSHOT OF BOCES SERVICES FOR LIVERPOOL CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT

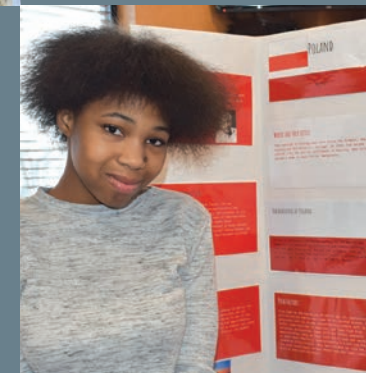


Liverpool's share of the 2018-19 BOCES administrative budget

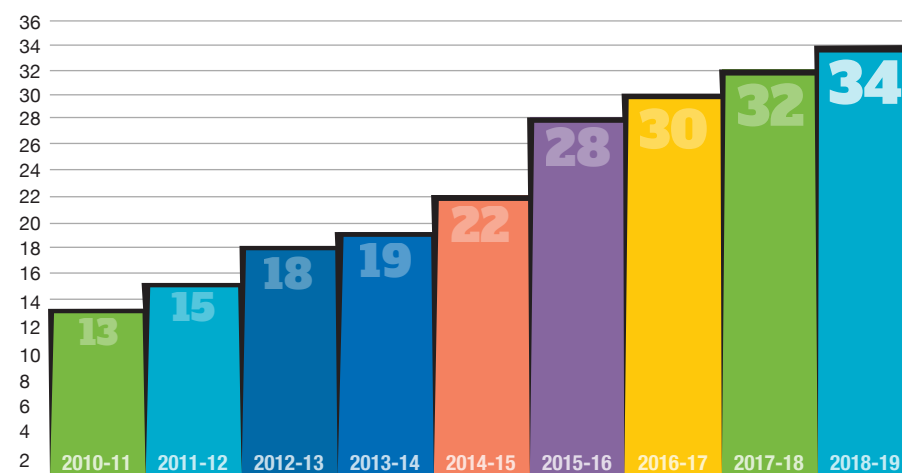
## Career & Technical Education

New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to real-world situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of more than 30 national innovative programs.

## OCM BOCES & Liverpool = Student Success



Innovation Tech proved to be a perfect fit for Tyler Miller, a Liverpool High School senior whose "grades, confidence and charisma have skyrocketed" since he first joined the New Tech high school three years ago, according to his school guidance counselor, Kayla Beyer. Tyler says he especially enjoys the family-like atmosphere of Innovation Tech, where classmates show great compassion for one another and the facilitators are friendly and accessible.

"Innovation Tech has given Tyler a greater appreciation for school," Beyer said. "He is able to find purpose in projects, and it drives him to want to do better. ... Tyler loves that, despite everyone's differences, the students and staff are able to come together as one. He describes our program as a community where everyone looks out for one another."

Tyler's leadership skills became apparent last year when he organized an inter-school basketball game among two BOCES programs. The feat was so well-received, it allowed him to present his project to a large audience at the "Exhibition of Excellence" at the OCM BOCES Main Campus. Beyer said it was amazing to hear about all the different steps Tyler took "to plan this event out to perfection, which he wholeheartedly did."

"I am confident this game will remain a long-lasting memory for everyone who took part in it," she said.

Tyler's love of basketball is something he hopes to pursue in the future, possibly as a coach. Before that, he plans to attend Onondaga Community College, then transfer to Syracuse University. His goal is to follow in his grandfather's footsteps and become a lawyer. A college-level public speaking course at Innovation Tech is proving to be a great way to prepare for that ambition. Facilitators say Tyler is bound to do well, and they will miss him.

"We turn to Tyler whenever a leadership opportunity presents itself because he is reliable beyond definition," Beyer said. "He volunteers his time to help us in any way imaginable, and for that, we are forever grateful."

## Did You Know?

The New York State Seal of Biliteracy recognizes high school graduates who have attained a high level of proficiency and performance in listening, speaking, reading, and writing in one or more languages, in addition to English. Of the 2,234 Seals awarded to graduating seniors throughout the state in 2017-18, 49 students came from the Liverpool Central School District. Awardees demonstrated presentational, interpretive and interpersonal proficiency and performance in the following languages: American Sign Language, Arabic, Bosnian, English, Nepali, Spanish, Urdu and Vietnamese.
