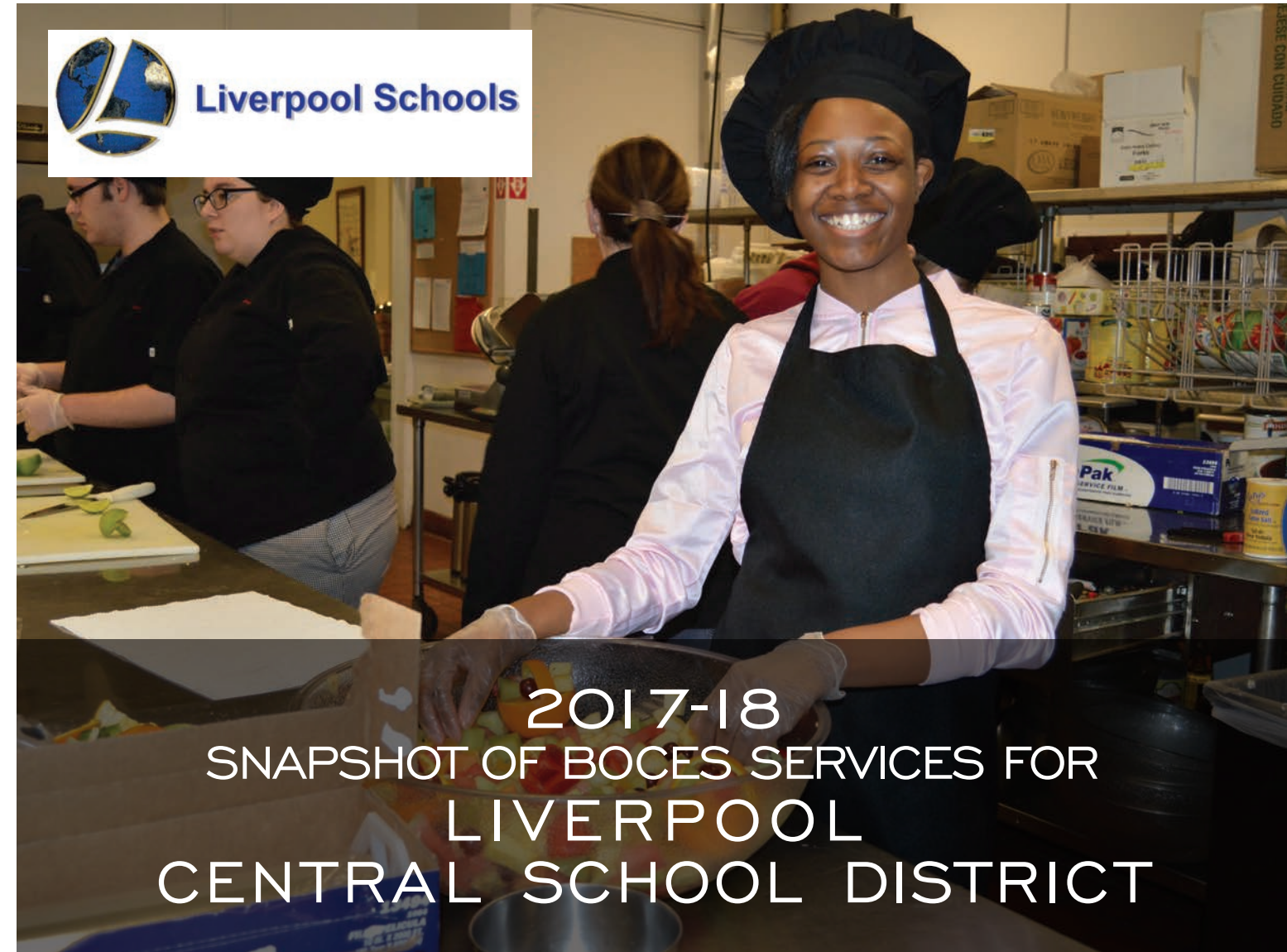

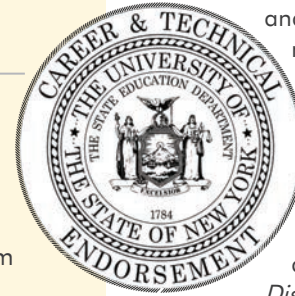

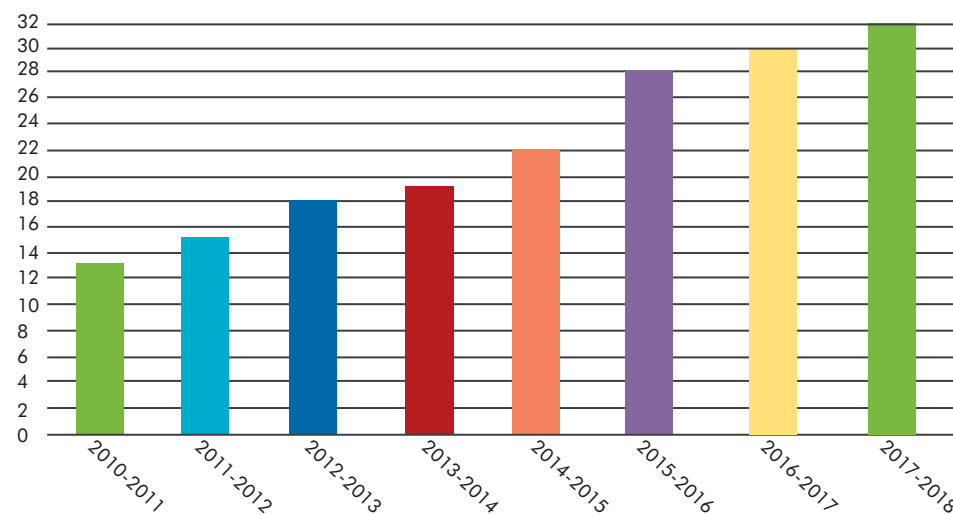
CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to real-world situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of 33 national innovative programs.

In 2017, nearly 400 seniors from OCM BOCES' component districts were eligible to earn CTE endorsements on their high school diplomas, including Andrew Alpuerto, Dylan DeForest, Ramal Kearsa, Jesse Lashua, Steven Ososkalo, Ricky Oundo (pictured on front cover), John Polakiewicz, Taylor Race, Kierra Richardson (pictured on front cover), Hunter Smith, Marissa Tyre, Michael Valerino and Nubian Wade from the Liverpool Central School District.

Representatives from the Liverpool Central School District have been attending Leadership Network Groups hosted by OCM BOCES Instructional Support Services. Designed as an opportunity for districts to collaborate within their schools and across the region, Leadership Networks exist in Science, Social Studies, Math, and ELA/Literacy. At each meeting, participants are tasked with deepening their knowledge of theory, examining application to practice, and reflecting on how to take the information and share it with the rest of their district. Liverpool's representatives include teachers, administrators, and school library media specialists, which enables the district to take a wholistic view of implementation strategies.
