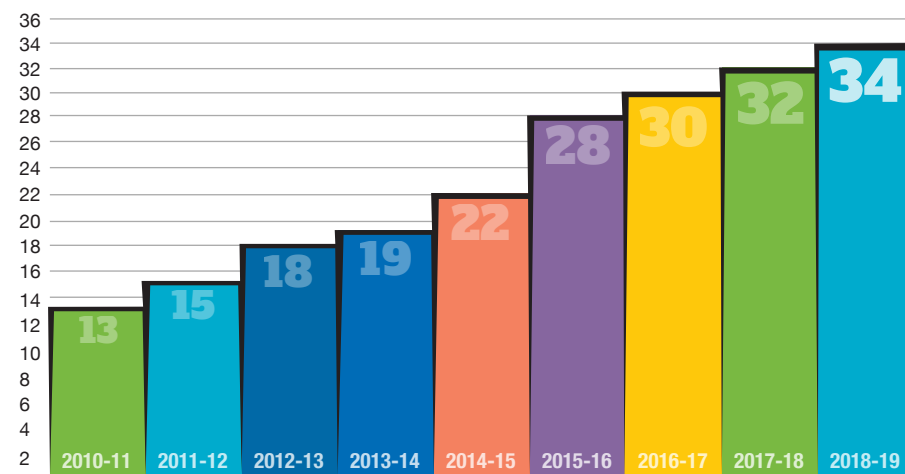
## Career & Technical Education

New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to real-world situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of more than 30 national innovative programs.

In 2018, nearly 300 seniors from OCM BOCES' component districts were eligible to earn CTE endorsements on their high school diplomas, including Solvay students Brooke Aldrich, Chandler Bulla, Alexis Gasiorowski, Jayden Hollis-Long, Elizabeth Montreal, Kimberly Morgan, Brandi Sarno and Matthew Solan.

Rosie Carioti-Darling has flourished during the two years she has been in the transitional SED program at Camillus Middle School (CMS), according to her teachers, Samantha Nadeau and Natalie Sgroi. Prior to the special education program in Camillus, the Lyncourt eighth-grader spent one year in a center-based program at the OCM BOCES Crown Road Campus.

"Rosie's social skills have improved significantly. She has built good friendships. She is a caring and empathetic young woman," her teachers wrote. "Over the last two years, Rosie has become more academically focused and strives to do her best."

She also stays busy. Rosie participates in chorus at CMS and recently took part in an after-school cooking class. She says her favorite subjects are chorus, gym and math. Her love of chorus complements her outside interests in singing, dancing and acting. Outside of school, she participates in a dance troop and the Syracuse Children's Theater.

At Camillus Middle School, Rosie is also an active participant in her OCM BOCES and CMS classes.

"I have learned skills like kindness and interacting with other people," she said. "I have learned to get to class on time — I need to grab my stuff and go right to class."

Others have recognized Rosie's positive influence at the school.

"Rosie is hard working and has a great attitude," said Rebecca Eassa, her eighth-grade math teacher. "She works well with others and is always willing to help others. Her positive attitude shines above all else."

CMS Principal Beth Lozier said Rosie is "bright and engaged, with a terrific personality."

"She just kind of sparkles," Lozier said.
