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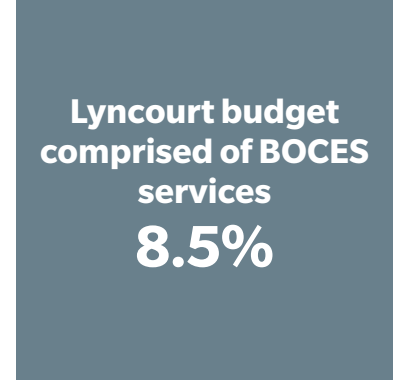
2017-18 SNAPSHOT OF BOCES SERVICES FOR LYNCOURT UNION FREE SCHOOL DISTRICT

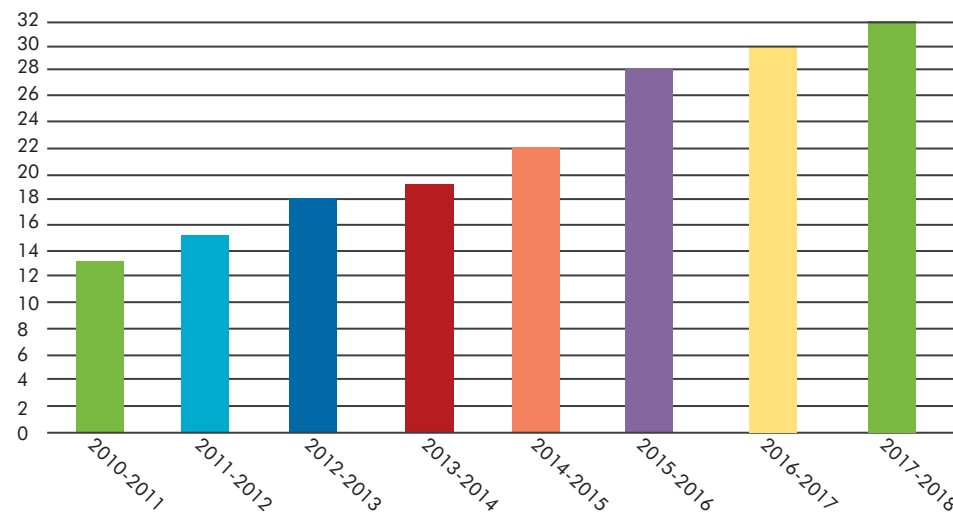
CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to real-world situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of 33 national innovative programs.

In 2017, nearly 400 seniors from OCM BOCES' component districts were eligible to earn CTE endorsements on their high school diplomas including Celena Bowen, Iveyshionna Ivey and Chelsi Sarno from the Solvay Union Free School District.

OCM BOCES purchased the **Forecast5** analytics software for all 23 component districts on a trial basis for the next two years. The program collates demographic and peer data for school districts across New York State and allows districts to access that information for the purpose of developing future-focused strategies to manage their limited resources and achieve improving academic success in today's challenging budget environment.

Jason Le of Lyncourt has made substantial gains since joining the OCM BOCES Stellata program last year. Located at the Crown Road Campus in Liverpool, the program focuses on helping students who are on the autism spectrum. OCM BOCES staff members work closely with students to help them with life skills, coping skills and academic skills.

For Jason, progress has been significant in all three areas. His teacher, Jacky Elder, says Jason is socializing with peers, using an iPad to successfully complete his schoolwork and enjoying several in-house work tasks that include getting lunch from the cafeteria for his classmates.

"Jason has increased his independence at OCM BOCES," Elder said. "He enjoys coming to school and participating in the hands-on activities. Jason does well when he uses the smartboard in groups, completes jobs, and interacts with peers. Jason has multiple opportunities at BOCES to try new things."

Jason's primary goal is to work on expressing himself to others, Elder said. Still, his unique personality shines through in the many activities at Stellata that Jason especially enjoys, such as bowling, swimming, going for walks and using a swing in a new sensory room called "the Zone." He has also developed a fondness for puzzles, both for schoolwork and fun.

Elder enjoys working with Jason and is impressed with his progress.

"In the short time that Jason has been with BOCES, he has made tremendous gains," she said.

DID YOU KNOW?

Educational Programs currently supplies Lyncourt with itinerant teachers. They are utilizing the Itinerant Co-Ser to provide them with an ELL teacher and a Family and Consumer Science teacher. Itinerant teachers are shared between two or more districts. They may work in one district up to .6 FTE.
