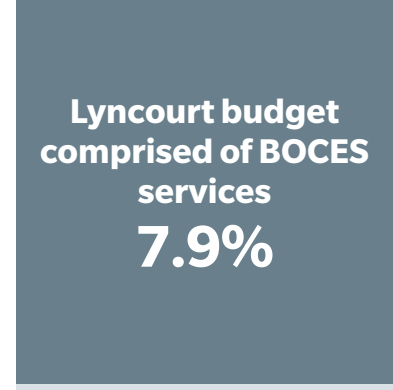

**\$15,445**



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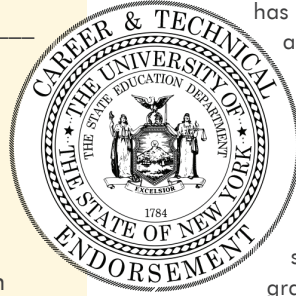

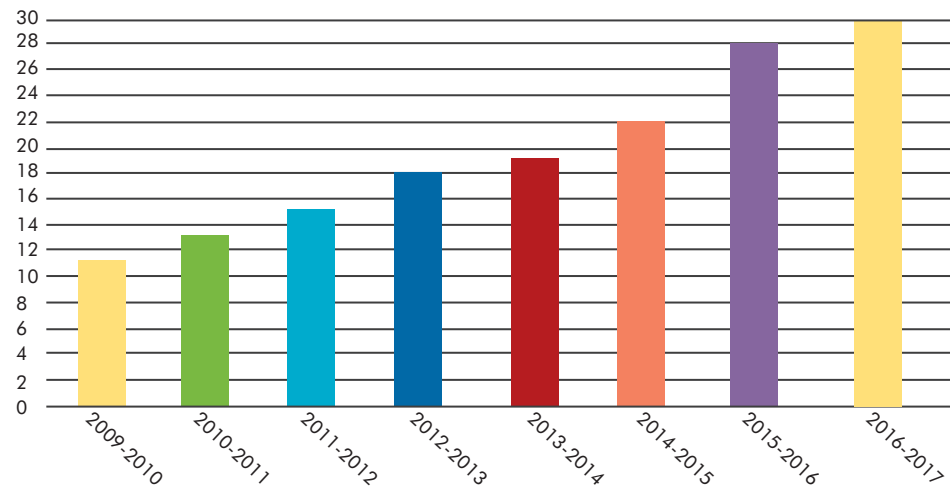
## CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to real-world situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of 33 national innovative programs.

In 2016, more than 300 seniors from OCM BOCES' component districts were eligible to earn CTE endorsements on their high school diplomas, including Solvay Union Free School District students: Armen Bagiryan, Jacob Betts, Kyla Harding, Ty Kaminski, Brittney McNamara, Brandon Messer, Jordan Micheletti, Josh Miller, Patrick Pallotta, Corey Soulia, Robert Stafford, Isabella Tartaro.

## OCM BOCES & LYNCOURT UNION FREE = STUDENT SUCCESS



In a recent class inside the OCM BOCES Crown Road campus, first-grader Brandon Mazariegos (pictured left with yellow and gray shirt) rolled out dough on a floured table, then used a cookie cutter to shape it into a bone for a fresh doggy treat. He showed it to his teacher, a wide smile illuminating his face.

Brandon's success in the OCM BOCES STRIDES program is apparent to his teacher, Danielle O'Brien, and other instructional staff. Brandon has benefitted from the smaller class size and visual structures that help him learn and be successful with classroom routines. Since he first started at OCM BOCES in the fall, Brandon has responded positively to consistent expectations in the classroom and participates regularly in literacy intervention, centers and the school-wide implementation of a program called Positive Behavioral Intervention and Supports, or PBIS.

"We see him beginning to develop positive relationships with staff and peers," O'Brien said. "He loves to play games with peers and especially loves participating in physical education activities."
