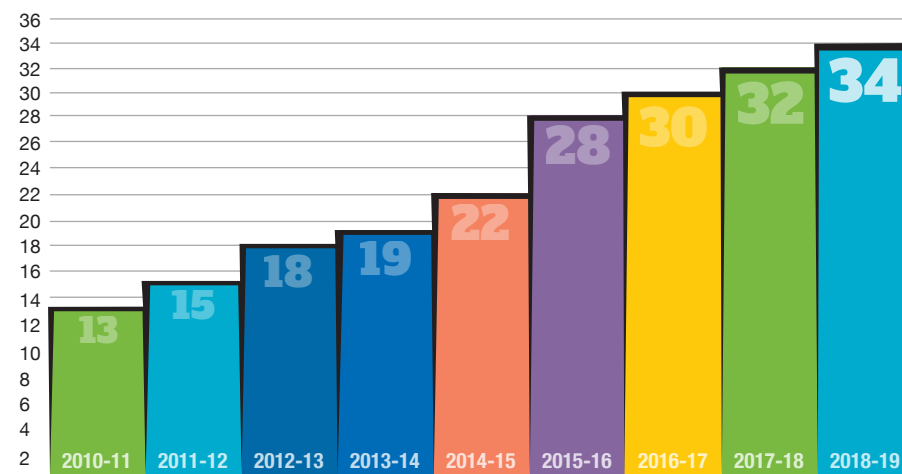
Career & Technical Education

New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to real-world situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of more than 30 national innovative programs.

In 2018, nearly 300 seniors from OCM BOCES' component districts were eligible to earn CTE endorsements on their high school diplomas, including McGraw students Donovan Avery, Jacob Benedict, Hanna Bilodeau, Tarra Brown, Justin Grant, Brandon Jones, Mason Jones, Larissa Little, Tia Mabry, Abigail Maricle, Lyndsie Neville, Jerred Stedwell and Makenzi Whible.

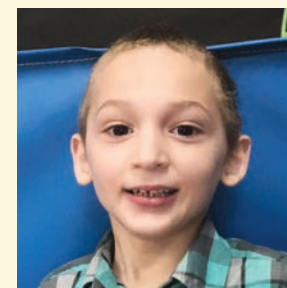
Number of classrooms in school district buildings that host BOCES Special Education Programs

OCM BOCES & McGraw = Student Success



First-grader Brandon Gage has benefited greatly from being part of the OCM BOCES SKATE program at Homer Elementary School. His teacher, Elizabeth Towne, says Brandon receives the tools and strategies he needs to be more successful and independent throughout his school day. As a result, he is able to participate in specials and other general education settings on a regular basis, one of the key benefits of the program being in a district-based classroom.

"My classroom supports his needs and fosters his independence," Towne said.

The SKATE program, which stands for Scaffolding Kids' Abilities Through Education, is specially designed for students like Gage who are on the autism spectrum. The program utilizes the TEACCH model, which focuses on providing a clearly organized and highly structured daily routine that supports the life skills, peer interactions and socialization students need to progress academically.

Brandon enjoys school and performs especially well in reading, where he is "very skilled at sounding out new words and using context clues to answer comprehension questions," Towne said.

He also loves building shapes with magnetic blocks, listening to music and playing instruments. His favorite part of the day is closing circle with "ABC Music and Me," a program that supports early literacy and other school-readiness skills. Above all, Brandon enjoys being with his classmates.

"He comes to school every day with a smile on his face to greet his peers and teachers!" Towne said.

Did You Know?

When a school hires a new school librarian, it is the role of the OCM BOCES School Library System to empower and support them as they begin their new position. When D'aniel Fish was hired, she was invited to join our Mentors Across Borders program that pairs new librarians with a more experienced school librarian in the same grade levels. As part of the School Library System Professional Learning Network and a member of the Mentors Across Borders program, D'aniel visited other school libraries and received mentorship in the areas of information literacy instruction, collection development, purchasing, and, most importantly, creating a Center of Engagement for her entire school community. Our hope is that the program leads to successful school librarians who build the skills, knowledge and confidence to be educational leaders in their districts.
