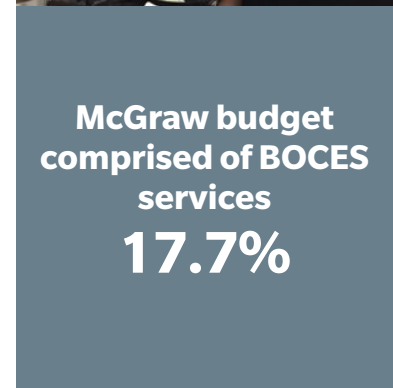
# 2017-18 SNAPSHOT OF BOCES SERVICES FOR MCGRAW CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT

## CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

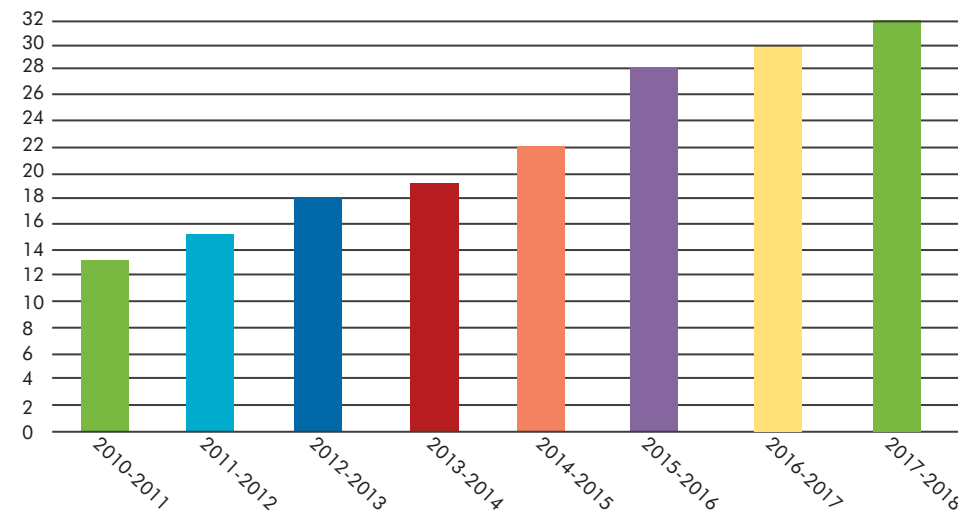


New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to real-world situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of 33 national innovative programs.

In 2017, nearly 400 seniors from OCM BOCES' component districts were eligible to earn CTE endorsements on their high school diplomas, including Anthony Alberts, Bridgette Bice, Lucas Cortez, Dakota Davidson, Dustin Hewlett, Devon Livermore, Kayli Marshall, Alexis Roy, Eric Smith, Erik Smith, Carter Towsley, Travis Walker, Spencer Welsh and Jordan Young from the McGraw Central School District.

Jazmine Craig, a senior from McGraw, has flourished academically and socially at Cortland Alternative School since she first arrived at the OCM BOCES high school in February of 2017. The small class sizes, caring staff and family-like environment have given her the perfect place to gain confidence in herself and her abilities. Her teachers offer abundant praise about her quality work, positive attitude and kindness toward her peers.

"I am lucky enough to have her in three classes this year," said her English teacher, Douglas Rice. "Jazmine is unfailingly calm, kind and ready and willing to learn. She is content to help her peers with their work without question or judgment, and I've come to rely on her as an integral part of a happy classroom. While Jazmine came to me with well-developed skills in composition, it has been a thrill to watch those skills progress even further, and I regularly set aside her work for use as future models."

Another teacher, Maria Britton, echoed those comments, saying Jazmine is a "diligent student who pushes herself academically." Just as important, Britton said, "Jazmine is a joy to have in class — her smile is contagious."

Principal Jayne Coffey said Jazmine is no longer the shy, worried girl who first walked through the doors of Cortland Alternative School last year. "She is easy-going, kind, genuine and smart with a great sense of humor," Coffey said. "She has embraced being at Cortland Alternative."

Jazmine credits the school for her success, noting her improved proficiency as a writer — she loves to write — and even the important life skills she has learned in many of her classes, such as a business math class that taught her how to budget her money. Looking toward the future, Jazmine believes Cortland Alternative School will help her attain her goals, which include going to college and eventually becoming a paralegal.

## DID YOU KNOW?

McGraw's director of special education and curriculum, along with several special education teachers, attended the RSE-TASC Transition Bootcamp training. The Transition Bootcamp prepares districts for their upcoming State Performance Plan #13 Self Review for transition that is required every six years by the New York State Education Department. McGraw staff engaged in a review of transition assessment data, learned how transition assessments are used to formulate Present Level statements in IEPs, reviewed the validity of Measurable Post-Secondary Goals and learned how transition activities are designed to meet these goals.
