New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students





They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in workbased learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed

programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by District Administration magazine as one of 33 national innovative programs.

"This is my brain on paper!"

McGraw sophomore Raven Davenport exclaimed this recently before long, scientific writings on a white board inside Seven Valleys New Tech Academy in Cortland. The display demonstrated Raven's self-initiated, self-taught ideas of "biological systems of organization eventually linking to the role of sub-atomic particles," explained Jenna Fleury, a science facilitator at the school.

More importantly, it demonstrated how Raven's experience at Seven Valleys - the newest OCM BOCES New Tech high school – has sparked a mental shift for Raven in terms of challenging herself and taking ownership of her learning. Being at Seven Valleys has given her the support she needs to work effectively in teams and as an individual. Her ultimate goal: to pursue a science degree in college and eventually become a chemist in the military.

"Raven has shifted her focus to engaging her brain in deep and challenging work, rather than simply doing what she should do to get the grades she wants," Fleury said. "She is seeing that, as she digs deep in thought, her grades follow."

Raven loves Seven Valleys because it gives her a much-welcomed sense of independence in her academic journey. Fleury echoed those comments, saying Seven Valleys is perfectly

suited for Raven because it gives her "the freedom to expand on course requirements to suit her interests," as evidenced by the chemistry concepts she explored to enrich her studies in biology. When Raven demonstrated that work on the white board, Fleury knew her work had paid off. "I was overwhelmed with pride and excitement," she said.
