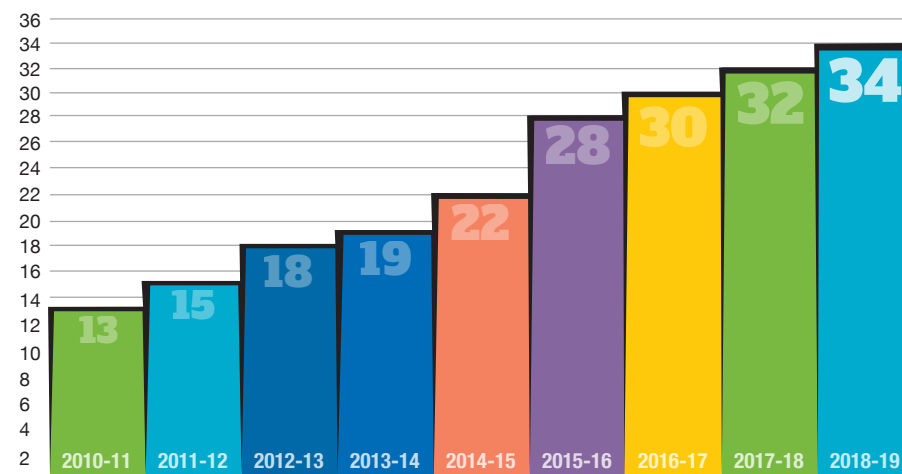
Career & Technical Education

New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to real-world situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of more than 30 national innovative programs.

In 2018, nearly 300 seniors from OCM BOCES' component districts were eligible to earn CTE endorsements on their high school diplomas, including Solvay students Brooke Aldrich, Chandler Bulla, Alexis Gasiorowski, Jayden Hollis-Long, Elizabeth Montreal, Kimberly Morgan, Brandi Sarno and Matthew Solan.

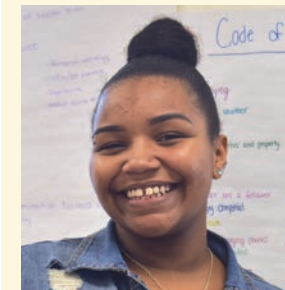
Number of classrooms in school district buildings that host BOCES Special Education Programs

OCM BOCES & Solvay = Student Success



When Chrystia Tejera-Johnson spoke with her guidance counselor last year about pursuing a career in physical therapy, she never envisioned taking part in the two-year Physical Therapy & Rehabilitative Professions program through OCM BOCES. "I was shocked," she said. "I did not even know this option existed."

The program, taught by Dr. Jennifer Tucker-Locke, is embedded at SUNY Upstate Medical University, in the heart of the downtown medical complex. Students are exposed to a variety of medical careers in areas such as occupational therapy, prosthetics, orthotics, athletic training, physical therapy and more. In addition, students can earn college credits in Anatomy & Physiology

through a partnership with Onondaga Community College.

Chrystia, a junior, has participated in the program for about three months. So far, she says, the college-level coursework is challenging and pushing her out of her "comfort zone." Still, she thinks the self-discipline she will need to successfully complete this program will prepare her well for finishing high school, going to college and possibly pursuing a career in physical therapy or midwifery.

"I have selected this career path because I enjoy interacting with people and helping others," she said. "BOCES will help me by preparing me for my future."

Did You Know?

The OCM BOCES Grant Writing Service helped the Solvay Union Free School District secure a five-year, federal 21st Century Community Learning Centers grant. The \$5.3 million dollar grant is being used to boost student achievement, provide a host of enrichment activities and help families support their children. The program is called BEST (Building Educational Success Together) and runs through 2022.
