
nized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to real-world situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed pro-

grams, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of 33 national innovative programs.

OCM BOCES & SOLVAY UNION FREE = STUDENT SUCCESS



Over the past eight years, Antonio Reinhardt has grown tremendously, both academically and personally, through the support he receives in the OCM BOCES Deaf and Hard of Hearing Program at Solvay High School. His teacher, Robert Haug, says the most notable evidence of Antonio's success has been his overall positive attitude and "willingness to work hard toward a goal," an inspiration that has been generated, in part, by the examples of his peers and experienced instructors.

Antonio says the best skill he learned at OCM BOCES was "how to study," a task he especially enjoyed when it came to his favorite subject: biology. Now a senior in the Solvay Union Free School District, Antonio believes his teachers' use of sign language was critical for his academic success and, ultimately, should help him get a job after high school. Reflecting on his time at OCM BOCES, he says his favorite part was "my teachers" because of their kindness, patience and humor.

DID YOU KNOW?

Solvay Free Union School District is working with the RSE-TASC behavior specialists to pilot a new way of helping teachers implement Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) at the classroom level. The RSE-TASC is providing weekly coaching to individual teachers as they navigate the implementation of PBIS at the classroom level. The thought behind the pilot is that the district would identify teachers to engage in deep learning this year, and in turn, serve as a support for additional teachers in the upcoming year. This innovating way of implementing PBIS will build capacity at the district and ensure the program's longevity.
