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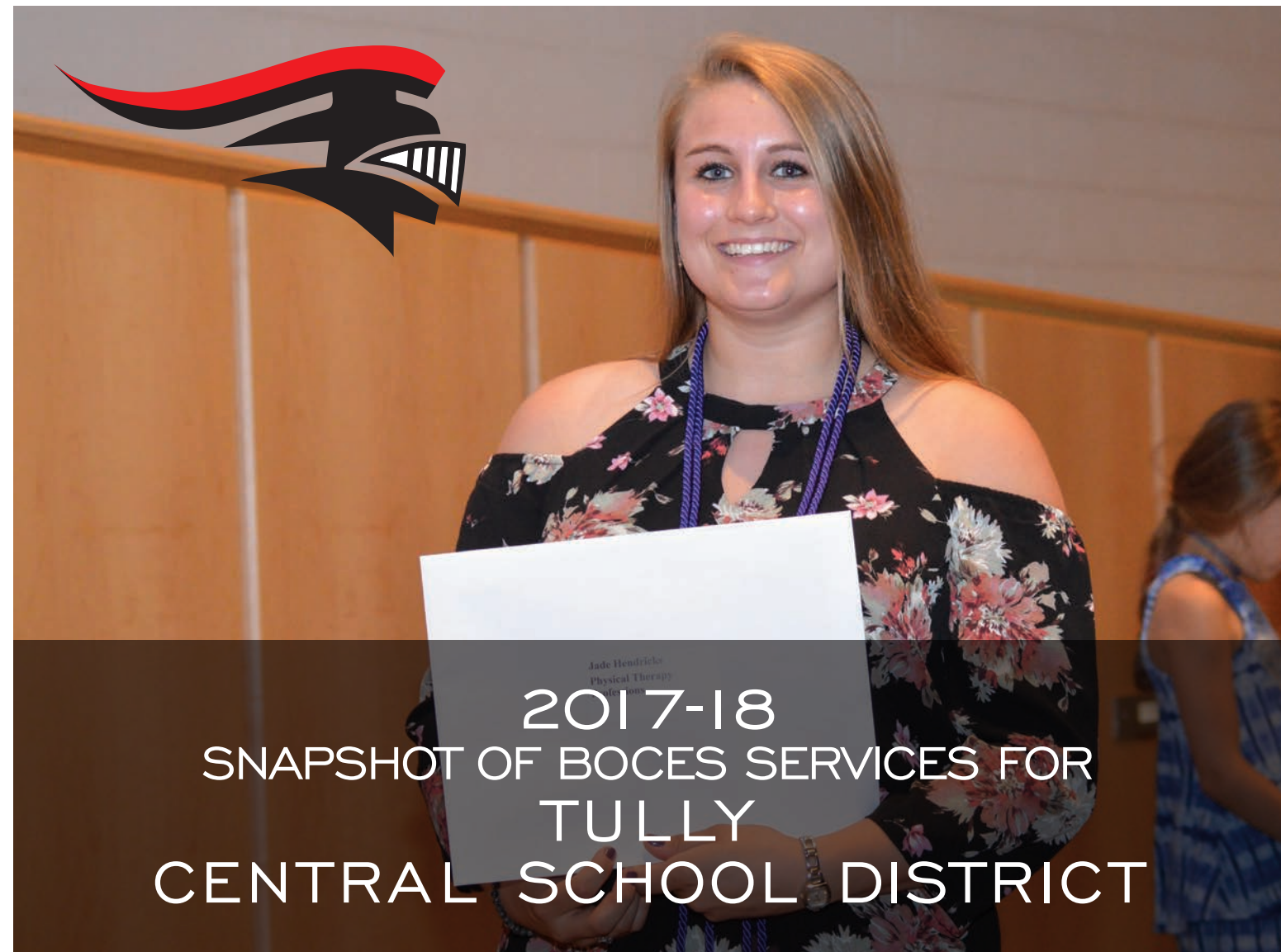
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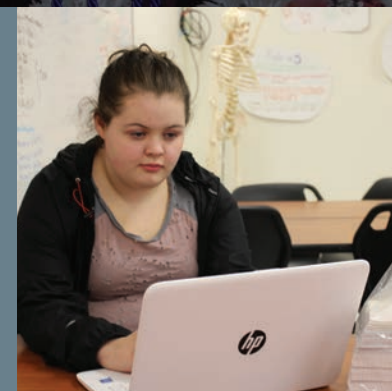
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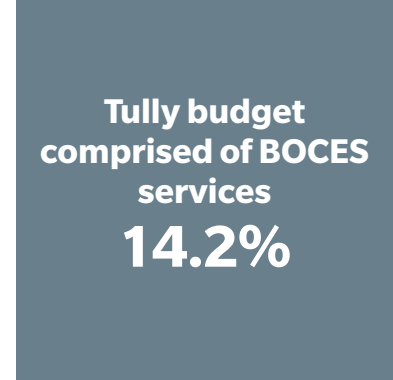
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BOCES aid generated to Tully for 2016-17 services \$770,962

CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

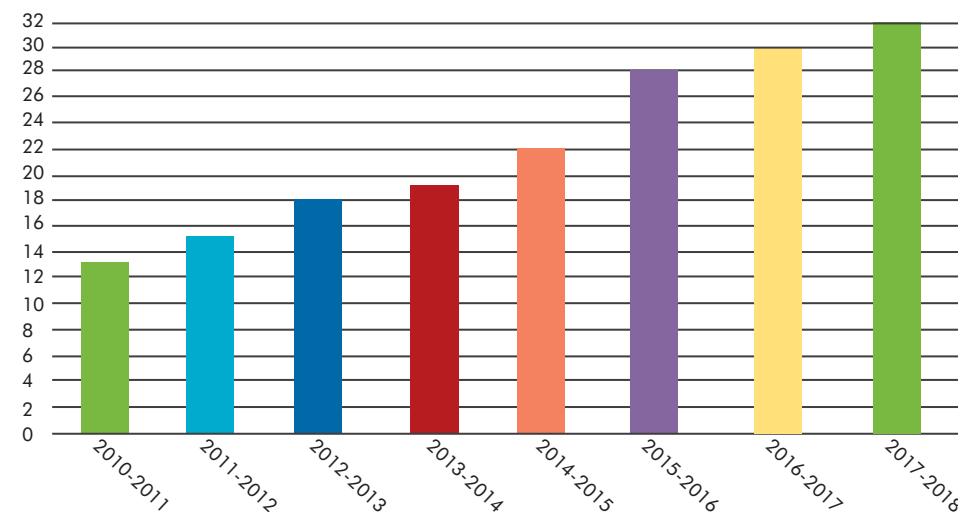


New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to real-world situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of 33 national innovative programs.

The program collates demographic and peer data for school districts across New York State and allows districts to access that information for the purpose of developing future-focused strategies to manage their limited resources and achieve improving academic success in today's challenging budget environment.

Tully senior Josh Canaan offers a long list of reasons for enjoying the non-traditional learning environment at Lime Hollow Nature Center in Cortland. He likes the small class size, the chance to work on-on-one with his instructor, the opportunity to make new friends and — above all — the myriad of activities he gets to experience in the great outdoors as part of this embedded environmental science program at OCM BOCES.

"All of these aspects appealed to me because it is something new and not something every high school senior gets to do," he said.

Chad DeVoe is the instructor of the one-year program, called New Vision Environmental Science. The setting is ideal because students pursue a challenging academic program in an environment that gives them access to an outdoor "classroom" of nearly 430 acres of forests, fields, streams, bogs, ponds, trails and more.

DeVoe said Josh "was the perfect candidate for the program."

"He works hard and takes advantage of opportunities," DeVoe said. "He excels in an outdoor, project-based environment and is a good classmate to his peers."

Josh said the program also fits in well with his personal interests and career plans. Josh enjoys hiking, photography, sports and fishing. He hopes to pursue a career that includes becoming a physical education teacher or outdoor recreationalist. His experience at OCM BOCES, he said, affirmed that ambition and also helped him improve his skills in public speaking and interacting with children who visit the nature center.

"It really gets you ready for college," he said.

DID YOU KNOW?

Just over a year ago, OCM BOCES School Library System hosted a meeting with Tully CSD school librarians, administrators and other members of their committee to help create a shared vision to implement Maker Education. Since that time, the school librarians and teachers have borrowed several of our Mobile Maker Labs to explore technologies to inform their purchases before spending district funds and grant money on resources, technology and materials. They are now successfully creating a collaborative learning space and opportunities for their entire learning community to explore, create and innovate. Students routinely interact with robotics, circuitry, engineering, and coding as they develop and improve their critical thinking and problem solving skills. It is exciting to see their vision take shape and to see the positive impact on student learning and engagement.
