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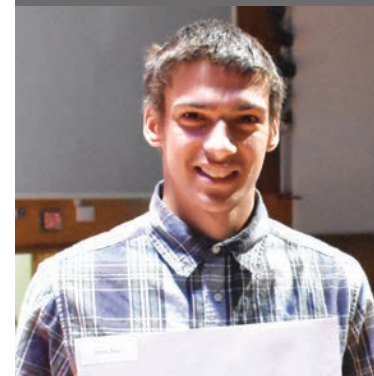

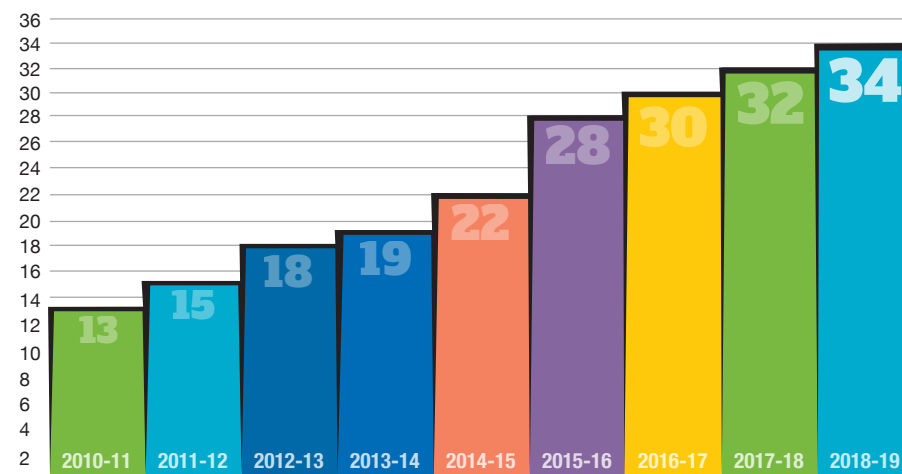
## Career & Technical Education

New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to real-world situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of more than 30 national innovative programs.

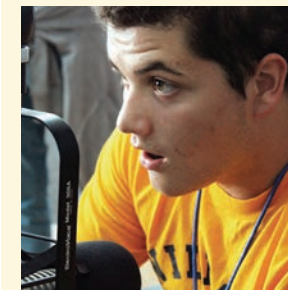
Number of classrooms in school district buildings that host BOCES Special Education Programs

## OCM BOCES & West Genesee = Student Success



With a longtime dream to work in sports radio, Ben Cerio knew that a chance to learn at WCNY and work side-by-side with broadcast professionals could not be passed up. Still, he remembers being a little shy when he walked in the doors of the Syracuse public broadcast station two years ago, in September of 2017.

"The first week he was here, WCNY needed someone for Read Out Radio," recalls Kathy Labulis, who teaches the two-year Media Marketing Communications program. "When he walked in the door that day, I took him directly to the radio studio and had a staff member instruct him as to what they needed. He was very nervous that first time, but has since worked with the same staff members in Read Out to complete additional sessions. He works hard, has a great attitude, and gives his all every time."

Ben says he enjoys the program's small class size and the potential connections it will create when he pursues sports broadcasting in college and later as a career. He also likes the chance to do college work — and earn college credits — while in high school.

"This incorporates all the things I need to know before entering this competitive field," he said. "I am learning about cameras and software programs and interviewing people. Most importantly, I am learning how to become a professional."

The appreciation goes both ways. Debbie Stack, senior director of education and community outreach at WCNY, said Ben "has been a wonderful presence."

"He is always smiling and demonstrates so many great people skills," she said. "He is the quintessential experiential learner: eager to try new things and acquire new skills and knowledge and then apply them for the benefit of others."
