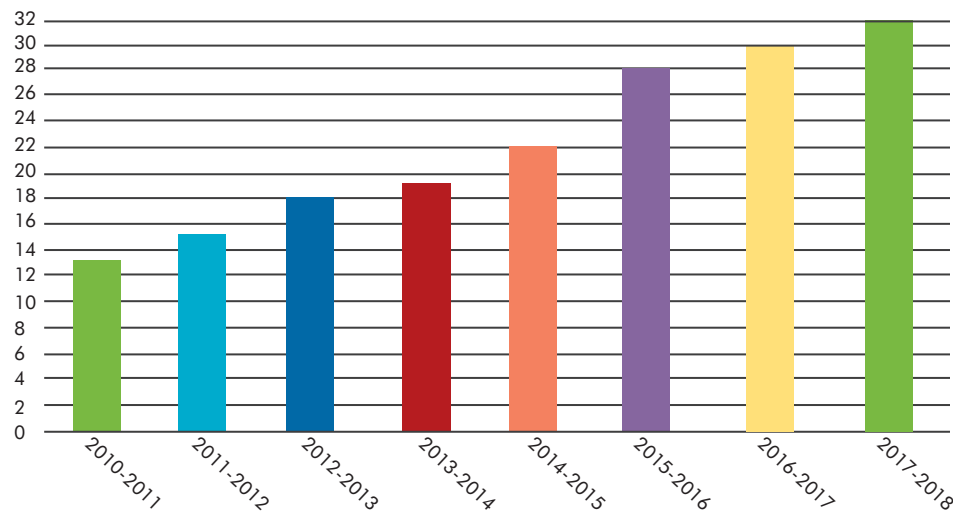
## CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to real-world situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of 33 national innovative programs.

OCM BOCES purchased the **Forecast5** analytics software for all 23 component districts on a trial basis for the next two years. The program collates demographic and peer data for school districts across New York State and allows districts to access that information for the purpose of developing future-focused strategies to manage their limited resources and achieve improving academic success in today's challenging budget environment.

## OCM BOCES & WEST GENESEE CSD = STUDENT SUCCESS



West Genesee seniors Brian and Kevin Nolan are identical twins with identical career interests: Both want to become unionized electricians, and both credit their aspirations to the Construction Technology Career & Technical Education program at OCM BOCES. One of the biggest highlights of the class was learning "how to wire-up a house that our OCM BOCES class built," the boys wrote in a summary of their experience. This summer, that house was sold to a developer who moved it to a neighborhood in the Buffalo suburbs. The twins like the fact that their schoolwork not only increased their knowledge and skills in electrical work, it also gave the comfort of light and power to a family in a new home. In general, the Camillus teens credit their Construction Tech class as helping them gain a skill they can use throughout their life, something that promises "a career and not just a job."

In addition to being "electrical," the Nolan twins are musical, as Brian plays the trumpet while Kevin focuses on drums. Both boys echo gratitude to their school district for enrolling them in the OCM BOCES Construction Tech program. They wrote: "It's a great class for students who understand you need to work for what you want in life instead of just waiting for something good to happen."

## DID YOU KNOW?

As the region looks to tackle the opioid epidemic, school district leaders are exploring ways to contribute to the prevention of drug abuse. Pivotal to the conversation is the acknowledgment and replication of work that has already been completed. The West Genesee School District is leading the way in that area. Superintendent Chris Brown leads a committee of superintendents interested in learning about West Genesee's coalition, its resources and work, and how to leverage the district's experiences to build additional coalitions throughout Central New York.
