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
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



New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recog-


> nized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to real-world situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed pro-

grams, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by District Administration magazine as one of 33 national innovative programs.

Special Education School Improvement Specialist (SE-SIS) and West Genesee Middle School are partnering this year with a focus on co-teaching. Teaching partners will also co-plan to meet the individual needs of their SWDs through specially designed instruction and differentiated instruction for all students in the classroom.
