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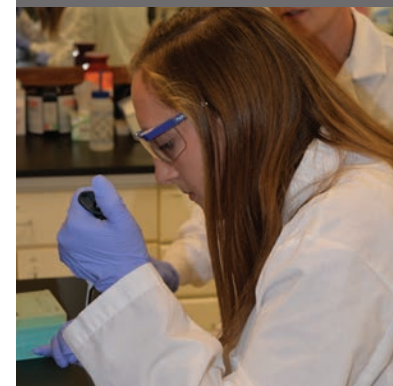
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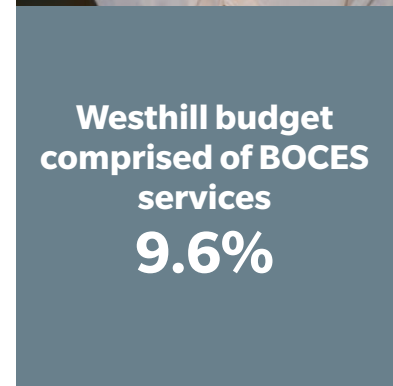

\$1,336,464



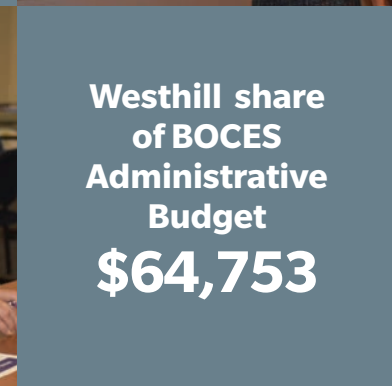

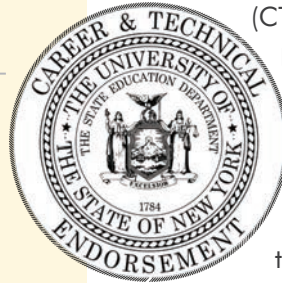

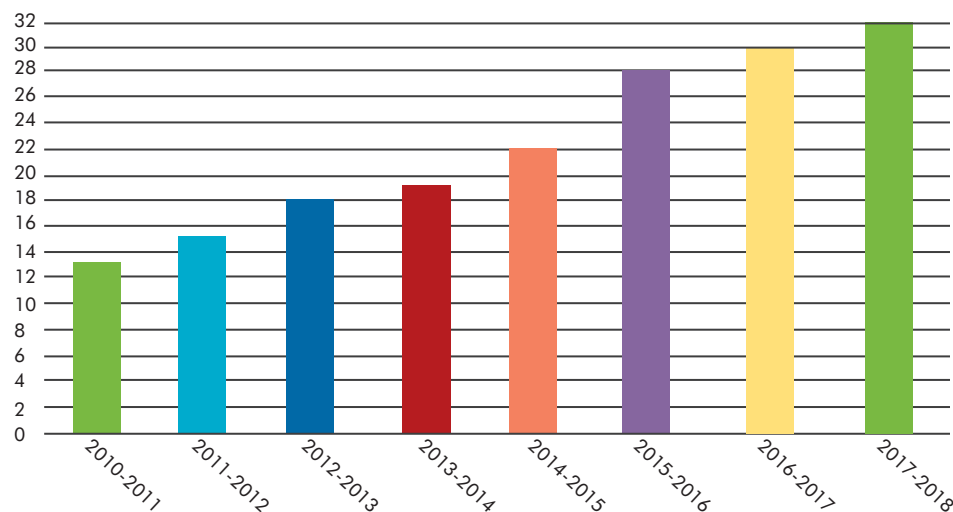
CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to real-world situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of 33 national innovative programs.

In 2017, nearly 400 seniors from OCM BOCES' component districts were eligible to earn CTE endorsements on their high school diplomas, including Sean Corbett, Morgan Coyne, Noah Durant, Mary Sakran and Kelsey Smith from the Westhill Central School District.

The Westhill High School junior says he has always been intrigued with taking things apart to figure out how they work. That curiosity is especially true for the amazing technology behind medical devices and procedures, he said, which he can explore as part of his real-world lab projects at OCM BOCES.

On the medical side, Mohammed loves the challenge of using the lab to figure out a diagnosis. His teacher, Charlene Maciak, MLS/ASCP, says Mohammed exhibits a great understanding of the way lab-tech professionals can reverse-engineer their findings to determine the cause behind a patients' symptoms. Maciak should know — she came to OCM BOCES from SUNY Upstate Medical University's laboratory environment.

As for his future, Mohammad predicts he might become a doctor at SUNY Upstate Medical University with a little bit of "Steve Jobs technology" mixed in. His lab tech class at OCM BOCES, he said, has given him a great place to start.

In the fall of 2016, the OCM BOCES School Library System hosted the National Ambassador for Young People's Literature, Gene Luen Yang. As a result of that visit, Westhill High School Librarian, Karen Fenner, began a journey to diversify the library collection to give students a better understanding of our increasingly diverse society.
