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




## CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to real-world situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of 33 national innovative programs.

In 2016, more than 300 seniors from OCM BOCES' component districts were eligible to earn CTE endorsements on their high school diplomas, including Westhill Central School District students: Craig Agostini, Jeffrey Cooper, Kimberly Farrell, Mara Henson, Zachary Oaksford, Peta Ogle, Lauren Prince (pictured on front cover), Sebastian Ramirez.

As a third grader from the Westhill School District, Thafer Abedrabbah attends the OCM BOCES TEAM classroom (Towards Educational Achievement for students with Multiple Disabilities) located at Solvay Middle School. Thafer transitioned from a center based program located at CTC to the program at Solvay Middle School this year. This program allows him to interact with his non-disabled peers.

Thafer has enjoyed attending assemblies, participating in physical education class and interacting with both Solvay and BOCES staff. He has improved in his ability to attend programs and interact with adults and peers throughout his school environment. One of Thafer's communication goals is to make eye contact and greet staff and students throughout his school day.

Thafer has made a successful transition into the TEAM classroom this year. He has improved his skills with the opportunities a district based classroom has provided him.
