DIRECTIONS for filling out **2013-2014 Final Expenditure Report**

Login into the [NYSED Business Application Portal](#)

Select the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) Reporting System link.



Select the **tab** that says “Applications, Budgets, Amendments, and Finals”

IMPORTANT: Sub-recipients that filed a 2010-11 Final Expenditure Report indicating expenditures for the full EJJ grant award were spent prior to July 1, 2011, MUST now file a Budget Summary via the amendment process for 2011-12 to access the supplemental funds.

Deadline for filing the amended Budget Summary was August 1, 2012. All funds must be budgeted and encumbered by August 31, 2012.

The Final Expenditure Report for all Education Jobs funds, including the supplemental amount, must be submitted no later than September 30, 2012. Compliance with this deadline will help assure your ability to fully claim all funds available to your district from the Education Jobs Fund. Do NOT file a Final Expenditure Report until the supplemental amount has been approved via amendment and expended.

If the Final Expenditure Report includes any expenses for obligations made after June 30, 2012, the district must inform the Department via e-mail to ARRA@FSAPP@nysed.gov. This will ensure that Department records are adjusted appropriately for districts choosing to obligate after the original budget period end-date (June 30, 2012) shown on the Grant Award Notice.

Section 1512 of the American Reinvestment and Recovery Act of 2009

ARRA recipient quarterly reports are required under federal law by Section 1512 of the American Reinvestment and Recovery Act of 2009. The purpose of this reporting is to answer important questions, such as:

- Who is receiving Recovery Act funds and in what amounts?
- What projects or activities are being funded with Recovery Act dollars?

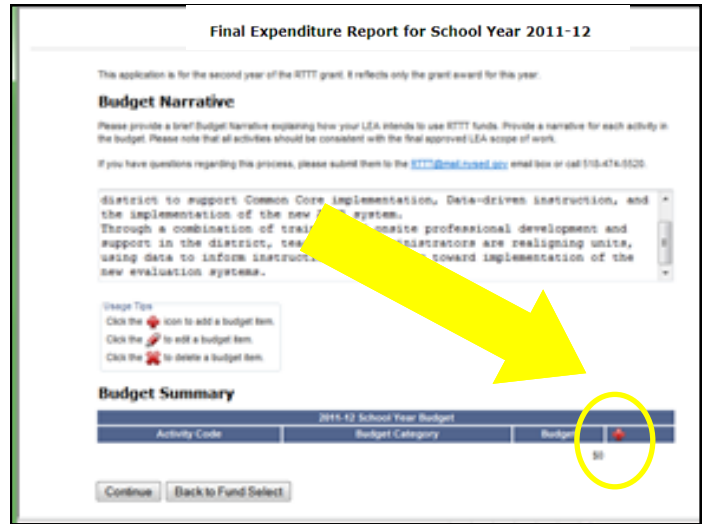
