Guidelines for Returning Critters

NOTE: A student in your class or yourself can opt to adopt any of the animals– to give them a home outside of the Science Center. The adopting person would have to provide an appropriate habitat and accessories. Be sure to acquire permission from the parents of any adopting students.

INVASIVES WARNING: DO NOT release living organisms into the local environment. Even though some of the organisms that are part of this kit unit may naturally occur in our local environment, they are probably native to a more southern zone and may contain invasive micro-organisms. Do not release them into the local environment – return them to the Science Center.

Living Organism	Packaging	Specifics
Anoles	in terrariums	The Anoles can be returned in their habitat. Transport the terrariums to the office for pick-up.
Crickets	in terrarium(s)	Transport to the office for pick-up.
Worms	in worm delivery container	Transport to the office for pick-up.

School Office = Living organism pick-up location for all Schools.
