

Attendance Policy

OCM BOCES Board of Education attendance policy is as follows:
Students are expected to attend scheduled classes and be present for the entire class period. A student who is absent receives a zero grade for participation and a zero grade for performance for that day and significantly reduces his/her chances of earning a passing grade for the course. **There is no distinction between excused and unexcused absences. No missed work/tests can be made up.**

- Repeat Course Full Credit (1 block a day for 26 days)
 - Students absent more than six (6) school days will be dismissed from summer school
- Repeat Course Half Credit (1 block a day for 13 days)
 - Students absent more than three (3) school days will be dismissed from summer school
- Initial (New) Course Half Credit (1 block a day for 26 days)
 - Students absent more than six (6) school days will be dismissed from summer school

Two instances of tardiness/early dismissal under 15 minutes will be counted as one (1) absence. Each tardy/early dismissal over 15 minutes will be counted as one absence.

Transportation

Please contact the students home district's transportation office regarding the location and times for student pick-up and drop-off.

If told that the district does not provide transportation, the parent and/or student is then responsible for transportation to/from summer school. Students should arrive no earlier than **ten** minutes before their first class begins and be picked up no later than **ten** minutes after their last class ends.

Registration Information

- Students **MUST** register with their home school counselor ; OCM BOCES **IS NOT ABLE** to register students
- Registration for courses ends on Tuesday, June 26th
- Regents only registration ends July 13th at noon
- There are **NO LATE REGISTRATIONS**
- Schedules will be available online July 1
- Enrollment and staff availability determine when and what courses will be offered; OCM BOCES can not guarantee block requests
- **Classes that don't meet enrollment criteria will not run**
- To be enrolled in one of our repeat courses a student must have already completed the course (including all labs for science courses)

Regents Exams

- All students taking the Earth Science Regents Exam **MUST** also participate in the August Performance Assessment (Lab Practical).
- Students who arrive more than 45 minutes after the start of a Regents exam are not eligible to take the exam.
- All students will need to provide photo documentation of their identity prior to being seated for any exam.
- Electronic devices will be collected prior to the start of the exam.
- Students should confirm start time and date with their teacher

Mid-Terms and Final Exams

Students must take mid-term and final exams on scheduled dates as per Board of Education Policy **“Accommodations for making up a daily grade(s) will not be available.”**

Final Average/Course Credit

BOCES does not calculate final averages nor award credit. The home school district will determine whether a student passes or fails and will award credit accordingly based in part on performance data provided by OCM BOCES.
