Précis

Updates

- SED update
 - K-12 Social Studies Framework Field Guide is expected this summer <u>slides</u> <u>one-pager</u>
 - SED might be forming a committee to study how/if New York will use the Next Generation Science Standards. FYI, <u>here</u> is what Massachusetts is doing. There has been some consideration of this approach which builds on the NGSS but does not accept it wholesale.
 - Five <u>recommendations</u> were presented to SED leadership about "Life After Race To The Top." They come from a larger <u>whitepaper</u> commissioned by NY's District Superintendents.
 - Redefine College, Career & Citizenship Readiness
 - Sustained (non-competitive) funding for PD
 - Instructional technology not testing technology
 - Provision of a "Road Map"
 - DDI for instruction not accountability
 - Additionally these three priorities for next year were identified and presented to leadership:
 - 1. Social Studies
 - 2. Literacy in the Content Areas/Technical Subjects
 - 3. Support for principals as instructional leaders

 - Standards and Teaching Practice
 - Supporting All Students through Differentiation and Scaffolding- July 1
 - PBL 102- Integrated Course- July 24 (ongoing for the year)
 - Geometry: Analysis and Implementation- July 25
 - Singapore Math Mash- August 18
 - Culture
 - Revised Responsive Classroom- August 19-22

 - CIA in the fall:
 - Regional sessions continue to be included

- PBL Coaching:
 - Full Implementation Model: 40 on-site days
 - o Can customize to 20-30 days on-site

- Business Community Partnerships
 - Big challenge for teachers is to find authentic projects
 - Event will match up teachers and business/community
 - o October 17 hold
 - Doubletree Hotel
 - No additional charge (but you would have to cover subs but aidable)
 - Through the CNY Ed/Business consortium
- Turnkey PBL Training and support for districts
 - For district facilitators to build capacity within districts.
 - Teams of up to five \$8700 (for component districts).
- PBL-NY Training in 2014-2105
 - PBL 101 sessions will be scheduled throughout the year. This is a four-day long training: BIE + Edutopia + New Tech = PBL^{NY}
 - The first cohort of PBL 102 has been announced! These courses are designed for two teachers (and, if possible, their teacher librarian) who are co-teaching an integrated PBL course. <u>The course</u> begins with four days of training and then continues throughout the year with networking, support, and PBL coaching. <u>Read</u> more about it.

Assessment

- 3-8
 - ELA and math shipping to scorer went well
 - Science did not (some districts likely to NOT send science again)

- CCLS Regents Exams
 - o Algebra 1 no surprises, more functions than expected perhaps
 - ELA 11 was hard but if instruction was CCLS-aligned students were ready
- June Regents Scoring
 - Heads-up:
 - Culture issues continue to be problematic
 - · Test security office doing surprise visits
 - Proctor training and documentation important
 - Scoring procedures and numbers of scorers should be followed
 - Papers and grades near 65 are receiving scrutiny (future comptroller focus?)
