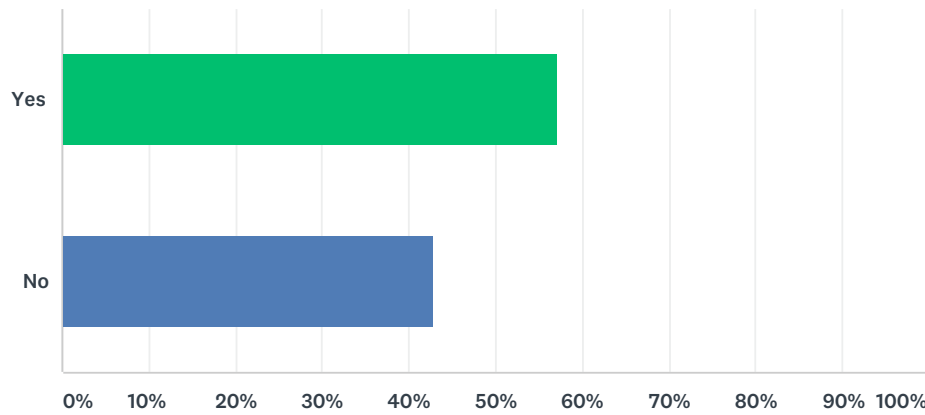

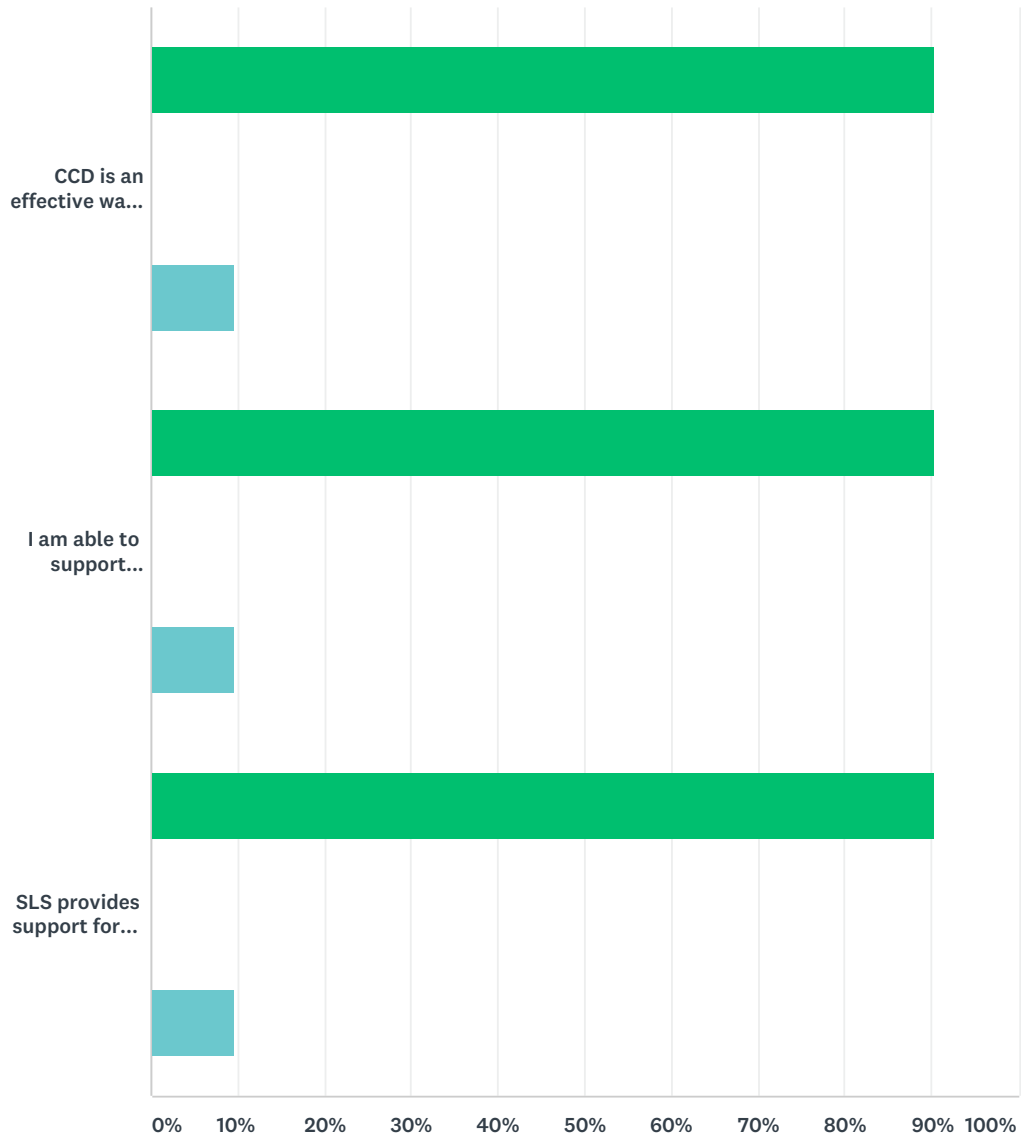

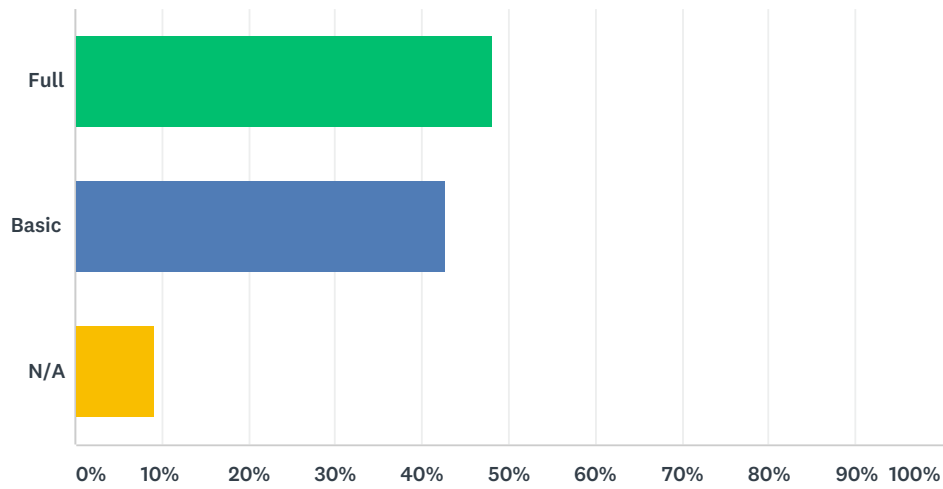

Q18 What level of support do you receive through the Library Automation CoSer?

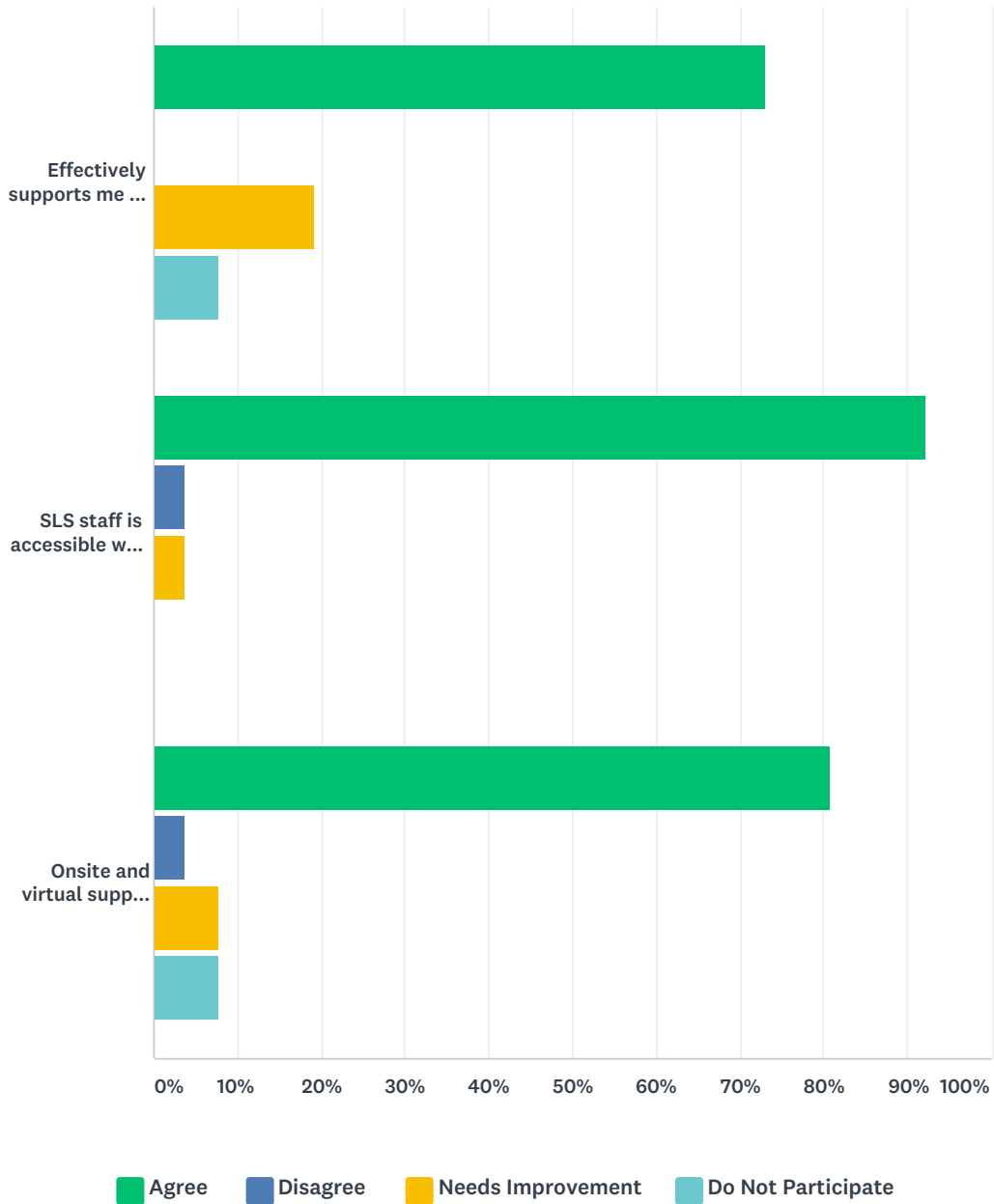

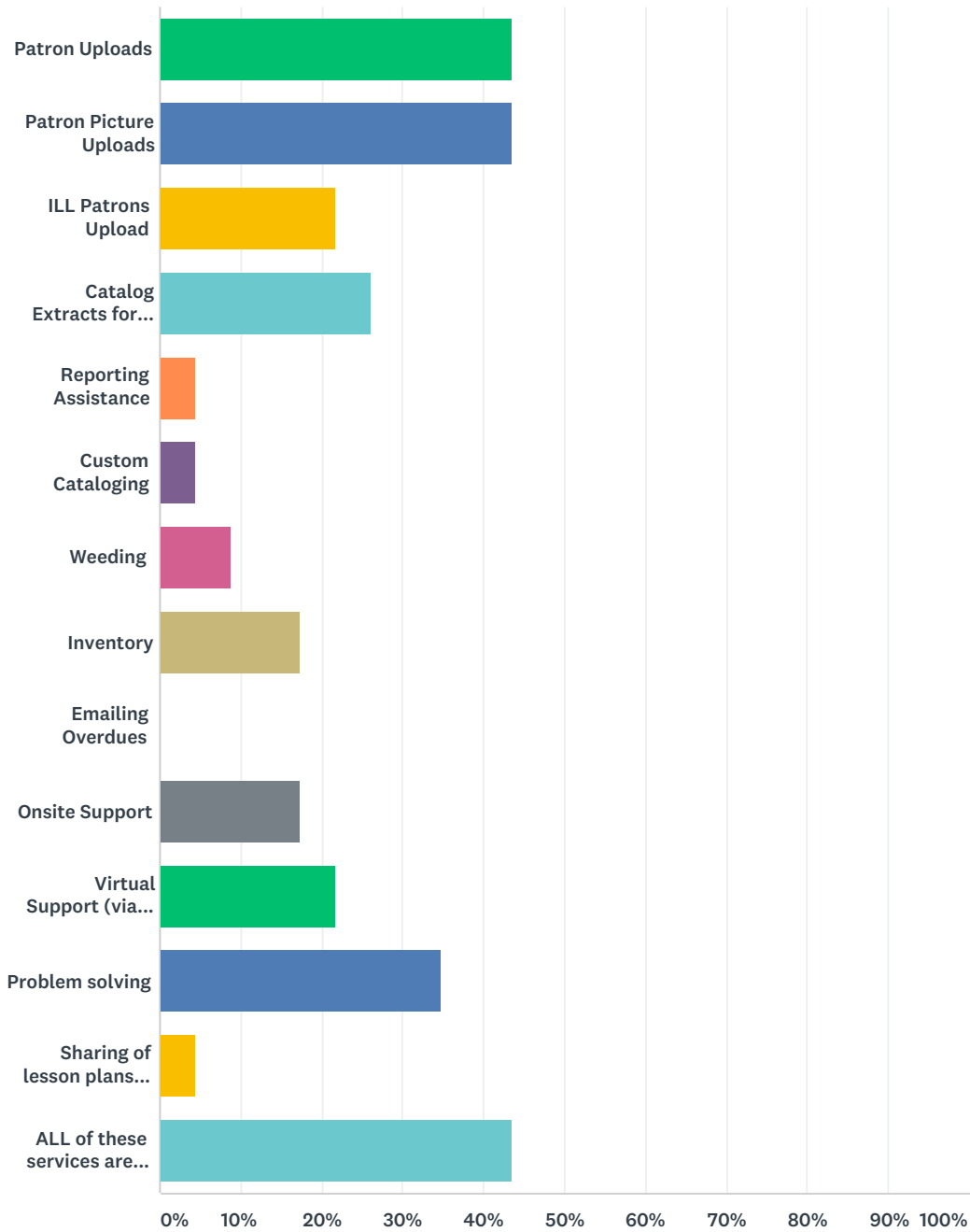

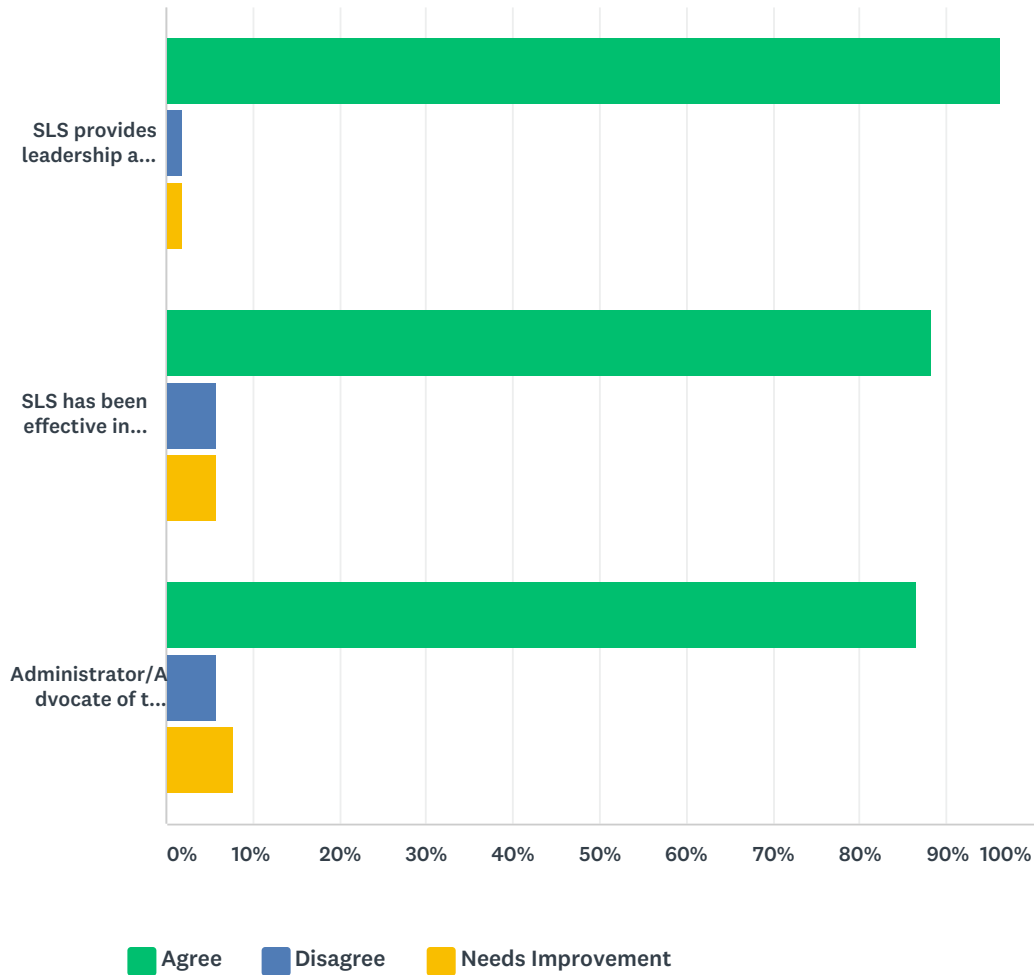
