

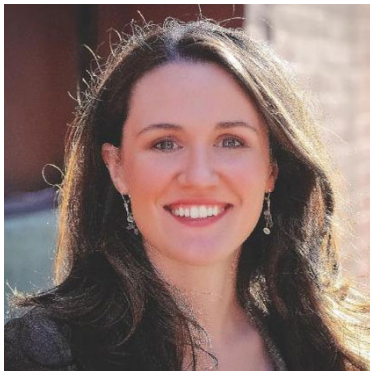

Homeless to Harvard: The Liz Murray Story is the 2003 film based on her life story. Murray grew up with poor, drug-addicted parents in the Bronx, New York and became homeless after her mother died and her father moved into a shelter when she was 15. In spite of this setback, she was able to graduate from high school and receive a scholarship to attend Harvard University.

Liz Murray's New York Times and Sunday Times bestselling memoir *Breaking Night* was released in September 2010. She is the founder and director of Manifest Living and a motivational speaker.
