

Science Center Planning

- Science Leadership Network (8:30-12)
 - Nov. 15
 - Jan. 24, 2017
 - May 9, 2017
- Survey to get baseline data to base PD on and to measure impact of work.
 - Characteristics of time on science, instruction, PD, and understanding of new standards
- Regional PD TBD starting in the winter
- Transition plan to new science curriculum materials to be distributed late fall

100Kin10 Grant

- We will be recruiting 50 K, 1, and 2 teachers from the region to focus on teaching engineering.
 - Grant covers either payment of teachers for PD outside of contractual work day or sub reimbursement
- Grade K PD will be late November or early December with weather unit being taught January May 2017.
- 1st and 2nd grade PD likely over the summer and units taught fall 2017
- Two year commitment plus building district and regional capacity
 - Phase 1 PD on new unit
 - Phase 2 addition of lesson study to conduct one research cycle.

NYS Standards Review for ELA and Math

- Public comment Sept 21-Nov 4
- Clarifications, movement, some combining
- P-2 ELA will have study group for developmentally appropriate considerations





Regional Scoring- Paper Based

- Need commitment by Sept 30 if choosing this option
- In consideration of equity, use of resources and high quality professional development, 2016-17 is the last year that scoring support will be "included." Districts can still pool included days to cover costs.

Computer Based Testing

- Operational and field test participation within this format is voluntary
- Have students and teachers ready if select operational for one level in a content--sample questions and use of tools

If participate in CBT.....Scoring

- The choice to participate in Computer-Based Testing requires participation in Computer-Based Scoring for CBT subject(s)/grade(s).
- To participate in Computer-Based Testing and Scoring, schools MUST partner with at least two other schools to form a scoring consortium (min 3 schools).
- Consortia can be intra- or inter-district.
- School Principals will be required to identify the location (BEDS Code) of their Computer-Based Scoring Center by a deadline in late Dec/Early Jan.
 - School or District Office within the District
 - School or District Office within a consortium
 - BOCES/RIC as part of Regional Scoring
 - Vendor
- Failure to meet the deadline will result in schools reverting to paperbased testing.

Implications...

 Careful coordination of what content and grade levels may be selected for computer based scoring
