District Profile

- District Enrollment: 343
- The 2017-2018 budget of \$9,964,395 supports many outstanding programs. State Aid provides 59% of the budget with approximately 37% from local taxes and 4% from miscellaneous sources.
- The District's administrative team consists of: a Superintendent of Schools, a half-time school Business Administrator, a K-5 Principal/K-12 Curriculum Coordinator, a 6-12 Principal/K-12 Professional Development Coordinator, a Director of Special Education, a Head Custodian/Head Bus Driver and a Bradley Mierke Head Cook.
- The District employs 70 certified and 35 non-certified personnel.
- The elementary school has a strong developmental program. Computer instruction opportunities begin in kindergarten and continue through high school. The Junior/Senior High School provides a strong Regents program. Dual high school/college courses are available through Tompkins Cortland Community College and the Syracuse University Project Advance Program. Curriculum development is an ongoing process throughout the school year and during the summer. The district participates in a full range of services offered through Onondaga-Cortland-Madison BOCES.
- The District has a full interscholastic program for junior and senior high students in the Central Counties League (Section III).

Our Community

The DeRuyter Central School District covers an area of approximately 89 square miles and includes portions of eight townships in four counties with an approximate population of 3,000 residents. The K-12 school building is located in the Village of DeRuyter, twenty miles northeast of Cortland and Interstate 81.

The Village of DeRuyter is located in Madison County, the geographical center of New York State. The district is basically rural with farming being the major occupation, and the school district is the largest employer. Many residents commute to their jobs in nearby Cortland, Syracuse, or Ithaca.

Typical of Central New York, DeRuyter is located in a beautiful area of scenic hills and valleys. The DeRuyter area is known as a sportsman's paradise for hunters, fishermen, and nature lovers. Within a thirty-mile radius of DeRuyter, tremendous recreational opportunities abound in the Finger Lakes, Oneida Lake, and our own DeRuyter Lake along with many beautiful small streams and lakes. This includes Highland Forest, a county park located within the DeRuyter School District. Wonderful skiing opportunities can be found close by at Song Mountain, Toggenburg, Labrador Mountain, and Greek Peak. Within a forty-five mile radius, you will find the cultural, educational, employment, and recreational benefits of Cornell University, Syracuse University, SUNY Cortland, LeMoyne College, Ithaca College, Colgate University, Cazenovia College, Onondaga Community College, and Tompkins Cortland Community College.

While the neighboring area holds many opportunities for the outdoorsman, the surrounding areas attract many visitors. The Syracuse/Cortland area offers a range of cultural and athletic facilities including the Carrier Dome, home of the Syracuse University Orangemen, the Everson Museum, and the Museum of Science & Technology, as well as Syracuse Stage and the Civic Center. Shopping may be done locally with our supportive merchants or in the surrounding cities and suburbs.
