Description:

Our ideas about research in K-12 classrooms are shifting. Research, as defined in the Common Core Learning Standards, is an inquiry-based process that asks students to build knowledge, rather than to merely seek information to prove something they already know or believe. This workshop will focus on research as an inquiry process through which students learn how to deepen their understanding of topics they investigate. Participants will explore ideas and strategies to help students pose and refine questions, find and access sources, organize and synthesize their findings, and express their evidence-based perspectives.

Expected outcomes: Participants will

- Identify the components of a Common Core-aligned inquiry and research process.
- Explain how a Common Core-aligned research project emphasizes questioning, inquiry, and deepening and explaining understanding rather than defending a position.
- Understand that inquiry and research are iterative, cyclical processes.
- Have the opportunity to develop a new research plan or refine an existing research plan to align with the CCLS
