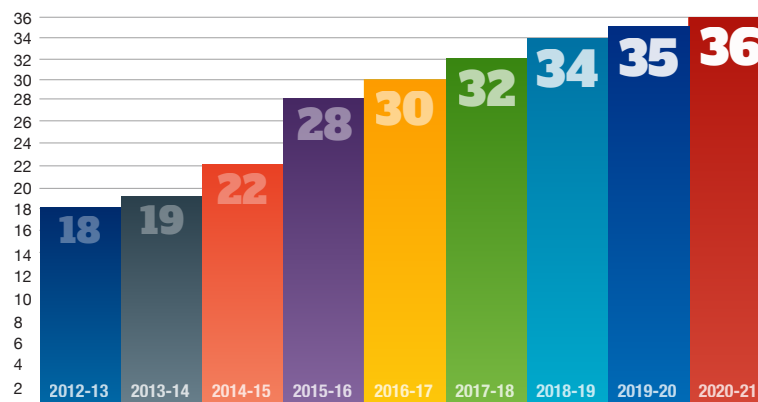
Career & Technical Education

New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to real-world situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of more than 30 national innovative programs.

In 2020, 441 seniors from OCM BOCES' component districts were eligible to earn CTE endorsements on their high school diplomas, including LaFayette students Jazmynn Crandall, Dante Friedman, Valentina Gilligan, Timothy Kramak, Destin Pitre, and Paul Shenandoah.

Number of classrooms in school district buildings that host BOCES Special Education Programs

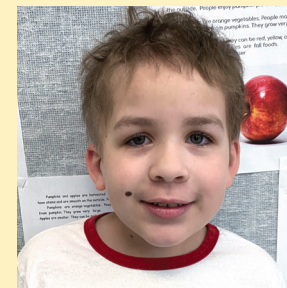

For Ocasio "Casi" Hazeltine, the OCM BOCES STAR Intermediate Program offers the small class size and academic flexibility that allows him work at his own pace and make steady progress, both academically and socially. The fifth-grader from the LaFayette Central School District especially likes reading and listening to books — "*Chicka Chicka Boom Boom*" is his favorite — and loves participating in interactive computer games to enhance his math and typing skills.

His teacher, Amy Whittington, said Casi has been working hard to learn a new schedule with new routines after switching from remote to in-person learning this fall. But the hard work is paying off — Casi has made significant progress with the independence that comes with being in school.

He is focusing on his work, developing relationships with staff, and interacting with his peers.

"With support, time, and humor, he is really making strides," Whittington said. "He really loves the feedback he gets in a school setting."

Socially, Whittington added, "Casi is blossoming in this setting." He has a great sense of humor, loves telling jokes, is friendly with everyone, and enjoys the built-in social activities that allow him to spend time with others — singing in a Zoom music class, spending time on the playground, and making snacks in school. His fun, positive attitude brightens the classroom and spreads to others.

"The STAR Program has really helped Casi make friends and find a pace that works for him," Whittington said.
