

Please Read:

Education Law, Section 3002, requires that citizen teachers serving in the public schools of New York State file a statement to support the Constitution of the United States of America and the Constitution of the State of New York. It is unlawful to permit a person to serve as a teacher in violation of Section 3002.

Civil Service Law, Section 62, requires every classified employee, except an employee in the labor class to file a statement to support the Constitution of the United States of America and the Constitution of the State of New York. Such statement shall be required only upon original appointment or upon a new appointment following an interruption of continuous service, and shall not be required upon promotion, demotion, transfer, or other change of title during the continued service of the employee, or upon reinstatement. The refusal or willful failure of such employee to take and file such statement shall terminate his/her employment until such statement is subscribed to and filed.
