• LOTE Checkpoint B exam creation:

- Test-creators seek a consistent common administration date of Monday, June 18th
- Test-creators ask that there be one consistent version of tests administered in June – and that they don't know which one in advance
- French, German, Italian, Spanish, and Latin exams have been created – some with as many as four different tests

- The team of 2-3 will create one or more SLO examples which we will post in a bank
- All content areas/bands will be invited
- Following a required 1 hr training, the teachers will have 3 hrs to independently create their example(s)
- Participants will be paid \$25/hour = \$100
- SLO examples will be reviewed and edited as necessary to increase parallel construction, appropriateness, and alignment with the SLO regulations and guidance.
- Share this <u>link</u> with teachers right away with encouragement to apply – we want to have a quick turnaround with this project. The application deadline will be March 26th and SLO training session will be 4:00pm on March 28th in Rodax 8.

Race To The Top

- Math Common Core
 - HS unpacking is coming up. It is pretty full TST and OCM will share the wiki
 - Math Solutions Common Core Institute in Syracuse in the summer will occur on August 8th – 10th on the OCM BOCES Campus. Arrangements will be made for 80 participants. There will be grade-level bands of teachers who participate, probably K-2, 3-5, and 6-8. Network Team districts will have slots at no additional cost. Other districts will have to pay for their teachers to attend. The number of slots and costs will be released soon, along with signup procedures. Because districts have allotted spaces we will register people outside of MLP, with BCIC members submitting names and contact information. There will be a timeline for responses because we will be making unused slots available to other districts.
 - Data Driven Instruction (DDI) will be the subject of the mini-lessons at this month's Lead Evaluator Training. Copies of <u>Common Formative Assessment</u> will be distributed there. <u>Six Shifts</u> of DDI and a <u>Balanced Assessment System</u> will also be distributed.
 - The Tri-State rubric/checklists for ELA/literacy and math "unit" evaluation was distributed and explained. We did not have time to go through the example, but doing so does increase understanding of the tool.
