**Précis**

**Regional Scoring**

- Based on the information in the survey, we have crafted a five-site plan.
- Districts who replied that they are not interested: FM, FP
- Districts not included because no reply: Marathon, Cincinnati
- Site coordinators will meet prior to scoring to ensure an adequate and comparable system of scorer randomization, anonymity, integrity, and security
- Scoring trainers will meet on April 4<sup>th</sup> for consistency and quality control purposes
- All table leaders will have a common set of instructions prior to scoring
- Administrators will not do back reads; table leaders will
- The designated site coordinator will make decisions during scoring with consultation
- RIC has said that they will provide all copies of scorer materials
- Fabius-Pompey and Fayetteville-Manlius have indicated that they do want to regionally score. We will have to check on the capacity of the ESM site to confirm room sizes and paper capacity. FM has slightly more than 300 papers per grade and FP approximately 70.
