- **Math Acceleration (and Double-Testing)**
  - Double-testing [slides](#)
  - What issues have arisen lately
    - 6<sup>th</sup> grade struggling with accelerated curriculum
    - 7<sup>th</sup> grade has to have more 8<sup>th</sup> grade in it
    - There is a big gap between what incoming kids should have learned and what they demonstrate (bigger than it has been in the past)
    - Move more 8<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup>
    - Compacting 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> into one year is tough (background just not there)
    - Increased attrition
    - Placement concerns as well as programmatic and curricular concerns
    - Reading is an issue, too
    - Students really need to learn all of 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> in order to succeed in high school math
    - We are in the middle of the transition so it is particularly rough right now
    - Important to look at district data about math persistence
  - Next steps
    - Facilitate network of accelerating teachers
    - Ensure that there is good vertical coordination and conversation within the district
    - Try to be creative to find ways that students get all of 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>

- Rethink placement process
- Pay attention to messaging
