- Looking ahead to next year in our schools
  - $\circ~$  Share the "big ideas" for the next school year that principals have for their school.
    - Integrated co-teaching (Onondaga Central and Cazenovia)
    - Flipping classroom in math at Onondaga Central, so far so good, kids seem to like it, lab after school for video-networking. Also, a math teacher at Cazenovia doing this. It's been great for when teacher or student is out.
    - Jamesville Dewitt: thinking about math acceleration a lot. All 6th graders will get what was considered enriched in the past. Acceleration will start in 7<sup>th</sup> grade. <u>Here is the guidance document that describes different math options</u>.
    - Liverpool also looking at re-aligning math acceleration. Have been starting accelerated classes at 5 weeks into if they can.
    - Liverpool starting to accelerate science, backing it up to common intervention period, ES.
    - Onondaga Central is looking at science acceleration with living environment. Not doing it yet, but exploring.
    - We discussed our contracts and whether they specify start and end times or a time amount total for the day.
