

#### Common Core implementation

- Update on curriculum modules look at chart of all districts
- Focus on math
  - How are the teachers doing?
  - How are the kids doing?

- East Hill (based on Split Rock), did a parent math night. Planning on another in the spring (with students).
- FM did parent nights some years ago when they switched to NSF programs (Investigations and CMP)
- Lyncourt has done a math night for the last three years. Had activities for students with parents. Playing some math games and share information about CCLS. Has had a great turnout. Fourth one is planned for this year.
- DeRuyter did one about CCLS in general. Focus was to explain CCLS and explain how tests and modules aren't CCLS. Has been doing Everyday Math but now that is changing, too. Was successful.
- Some pleasantly surprised about students being able to do more than we have asked of kids in the past.
- Module angst seems to be dying down a little in these places.
- Teachers pay teachers is a great resource.
- Math backpacks have been put together and are ready in the classrooms and contain resources in classes that kids need.
- Why Before How is a book to check out.
- Using My Math at Liverpool. The transition was somewhat difficult for parents. Given teachers a good guide. Good lesson design. Moved from Everyday Math in the past. Includes differentiation. Fits well with Daily 5.
- K-2 Assessment at the end of the modules is time-consuming.
  Using the rubrics directly can help (calibration would help).
- Solvay moved to My Math. Did parent night- parents with kids, to do some games and activities.
