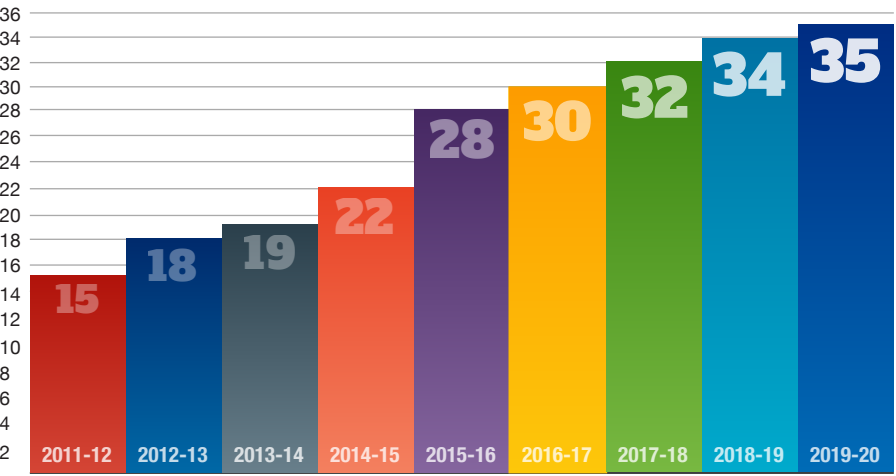
Career & Technical Education

New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to real-world situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of more than 30 national innovative programs.

In 2019, nearly 440 seniors from OCM BOCES' component districts were eligible to earn CTE endorsements on their high school diplomas, including LaFayette student Carlee Clarke.

For LaFayette junior Naomi Marie Gibson, the OCM BOCES STAR program at Homer High School was just what she needed to help her come out of her shell. After five years in the program, Naomi has learned to better advocate for herself. Naomi's teachers and peers have watched her transform from a quiet and shy student, to one who is outgoing, helpful, and self-motivated. With OCM BOCES, Naomi is also learning life skills needed to live independently, including time management and organizational skills, career planning, and creating a strategy to follow once she exits the program.

"I feel Naomi has benefited from the program because our class allows students to really express themselves," said her teacher, Rebekah Stull. "Our classroom has daily talks about what our needs

are and how we feel. We also discuss what the real world is going to look like, and we prepare for that.Naomi is able to put all her research and learning into practice before having to live it on her own. She is motivated to do her best in our classroom environment to be a productive member of society."

Naomi loves animals and hopes to one day work in a veterinarian's office as a veterinarian technician. Her time with OCM BOCES has helped her to prepare for entering this job field.

"BOCES has helped me by giving me more time to complete tasks," Naomi said. "In my classroom, I feel it is a judgement-free zone, so I am able to be myself. My teacher motivates me to do my best and teaches me what to expect after high school."
