Career & Technical Education

New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to real-world situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by District Administration magazine as one of more than 30 national innovative programs.

In 2019, nearly 440 seniors from OCM BOCES' component districts were eligible to earn CTE endorsements on their high school diplomas, including Solvay students Caitlyn Bianco, Davon Campbell, Milanna Dopp, Kaiya Gulliver, Shahid Hutcherson, Peyton Ross, Joshua Salvetti, Trevor Todd, and DiMar Willis

Solvay senior Joshua Shields looks forward to spending half his school day at SUNY Upstate Medical University, where he and his classmates are learning medical terminology, studying anatomy and physiology, and going on clinical rotations that give them an up-close look at a wide variety of medical careers, including physical therapy, surgery, prosthetics, and radiation.

For Joshua, the experience is perfect. He hopes to be a cardiologist, a career inspired by the heartrelated complications that afflicted his late grandfather.

"I like the experience of being able to shadow professionals, as well as learning practical skills I can use," he said of the New Vision Medical Professions program.

Instructor Robin Willey said the program is especially suited for Joshua, whose interest in the health-care field seems a good fit for his caring nature and exceptional work ethic.

"The two words that come to mind when I think of Joshu are empathy and maturity," Willey said. "He exudes a compassionate nature. He is thoughtful, insightful, selfless and wise beyond his years. His ability to balance all of his responsibilities is admirable!"

Joshua admits the program has helped him with one of his most persistent struggles: procrastination. That's because he has to constantly remain disciplined to juggle the demands of the program, his other schoolwork, and the hours he spends working as a supervisor at Arby's.

"This program has really forced me to deal with this," he said. "I'm upholding my grades, working, and excelling."
