
Career & Technical Education

New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to real-world situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of more than 30 national innovative programs.

In 2019, nearly 440 seniors from OCM BOCES' component districts were eligible to earn CTE endorsements on their high school diplomas, including Tully students Bedford Logan, Blackburn Joshua, Bruns David, Bunaisky Ryan, Cornwell Mitchell Curtis Mariah, Delavan Halee, Delles Mackenzie, Geiss Vincent, Hayes Kaitlyn, Hiltbrand Tarissa, Kirk Rachael, Macie Caleb, Morgan Kaitlyn, Trammel Cameron, Walowsky Zachary, Wiers Alexander, and Zilberman Timothy.

As a second-year student in the OCM BOCES Auto Collision program, Tully senior Ashton Henry excels at non-structural metal repair, welding, estimation, and refinishing, according to his instructor, Dale Gendron. In addition, Henry has acquired invaluable “soft skills” that will give him a leg up in any career he pursues after high school.

“Ashton is skilled at problem-solving, teamwork, and collaboration,” Gendron said. “He is a self-starting and enthusiastic technician. He is very helpful when working with his peers. His initiative makes him a leader in the collision lab and the classroom.”

Ashton says he enjoys the Auto Collision program because it has given him an opportunity to meet other students who share his interests. Even more important, he says, it has given him practical experience and newfound confidence in his career path.

“With this program, I can see and use what is actually in a real-world shop,” he said. “I really enjoy the hands-on work.”

Overall, Gendron says, Ashton has had a positive impact on the program. He will be missed next year.

“Ashton's greatest strengths are his positive attitude, charismatic character, and pleasant demeanor, both in the classroom setting and during shop labs,” Gendron said. “His ability to learn constructively and work cooperatively makes him a leader and role model.”
