#### Career & Technical Education

New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to realworld situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of more than 30 national innovative programs.

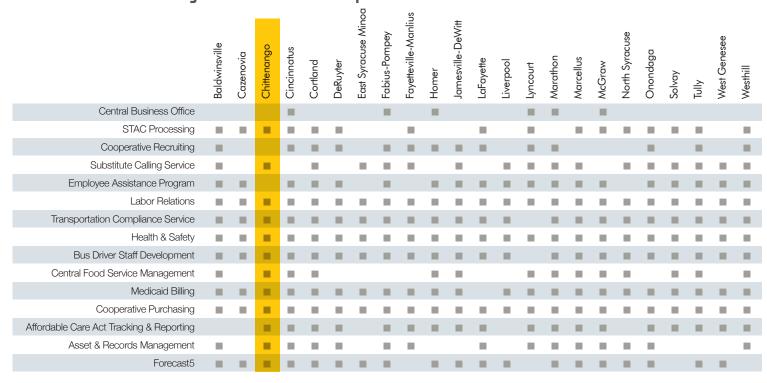

# OCM BOCES & Chittenango = Student Success



Chittenango junior Edith Serviss has several reasons for joining the OCM BOCES Early Childhood Education program at Bridgeport Elementary School. The in-district location is new this year, offering an on-site classroom experience for high school students as well as opportunities for them to put their knowledge and skills into practice by working directly with young children at the school.

"I really like the Early Childhood Education program because I want to be a teacher and work with children," she said. "I also like that it is so involved — I attend the program for half a day, so much longer than a typical high school class. I also like that we're not in a classroom all day, that we're actually in classrooms with Pre-K students practicing skills we are learning. Finally, I like that this site is in my (home) district."

She also mentioned the added bonus of earning a math and science credit as part of the program.

Jed Kissane, her Early Childhood Education teacher, said Edith has performed notably well in the program. Since she started in September, her confidence has grown both within the OCM BOCES classroom and in her direct experiences with children, he said.

"It's challenging and powerful to work with young children," he said. "Edith has embraced this challenge, and she has found it to be energizing and rewarding despite apprehensions about how it might go."

Edith noted one project in particular that she really enjoyed. It was called "Designing a Classroom" — a project in which students had to create a financial proposal for purchasing furniture, materials and toys for a classroom within a set budget.

Kissane praised Edith for her work ethic and for always being willing to share her thoughts, ideas and observations with her classmates, especially after their sessions with children.

"I'm excited to have her work with our group as we all continue to grow and learn," he said.

#### Did You Know?

The Chittenango Central School District has two students attending the OCM BOCES Virtual Learning Academy (VLA) during the 2022-2023 school year.
