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


#### Career & Technical Education

New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to realworld situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of more than 30 national innovative programs.

In 2022, 294 seniors from OCM BOCES' component districts were eligible to earn CTE endorsements on their high school diplomas, including Cincinnatus students Dakota Carolan, Ethan Chrysler, Kennith Craft, Katie Finn, Connor Gates, Jack Gates, Layne Jack, James Johnson, Curtis Perkins, Jacob Pranger, Allen Sanford, Oliver Slack, and Aurora Torrance.

# OCM BOCES & Cincinnatus = Student Success



Joshua Enright is a third-grader in the new OCM BOCES STAR program at Cincinnatus Elementary School. He is the perfect example of a student who has progressed over the past three years from center-based programs at OCM BOCES to a less restrictive, more independent school environment through an in-district classroom. In kindergarten, Joshua started with the OCM BOCES Stellata classroom for children with autism, then progressed in first and second grades to the less restrictive SKATE program and now STAR.

"I think the STAR program is a nice fit for Josh because he is supported throughout his day," said his teacher, Amy Whittington. "He receives a personalized and tailored approach to his learning and instruction."

The STAR curriculum includes life skills, community-based instruction, academics, related services, and specials. This year, Josh has shown a particular interest in science, math, and learning about budgeting and money. He also likes to take out books from the school library. He is especially adept at using technology, especially through his Chromebook, which he can navigate "like a pro" and successfully track his progress with web-based platforms such as Splash Learn, Vizzle, Epic and ABCya.

"He is our ambassador of goodwill, quietly greeting staff and students in the hallway or cafeteria," Whittington said.

Social worker Katie Twigg said Josh is "smart, funny, and resilient. He loves to interact with his peers in small-group settings. He is always willing to learn new things. He continues to grow as a student and has a bright academic future ahead!"

Josh has also been warmly welcomed by his classroom neighbors.

"Seeing Josh smile and look up at me when I stop by makes my day!" said Julia Marion, a veteran educator at Cincinnatus who teaches across the hall. "He checks in with me at the end of the day, too, usually with a joke or fun fact to share."

### Did You Know?

The Cincinnatus Central School district had a clear focus on mathematics during the 2021-2022 school year. OCM BOCES provided math support with instructional coaching for mathematics teachers in grades 5-12, and a math curriculum audit in grades K-4. Both projects looked at instructional practices and curricular resources. This work led to a full review of the math curricular materials being used K-4, and a better understanding of the instructional practices occurring at the secondary level. Information from the math audit was compiled in a report and shared with building and district administrators.
