
Career & Technical Education

New York State's approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to realworld situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of more than 30 national innovative programs.

In 2022, 294 seniors from OCM BOCES' component districts were eligible to earn CTE endorsements on their high school diplomas, including LaFayette students James Clemens, Evan Luteran, and Zachariah Powless.

Throughout her childhood and teenage years, Charlotte loved doing hair, makeup, nails and fashion design during her free time. Now, in the OCM BOCES program, she can hone those skills to pursue her dream career as a hair color specialist.

"I have always loved playing around with hair and makeup, so when I got the opportunity to participate in BOCES, I knew I had to take the class," she said. "To get my cosmetology education for free and be able to apply for my license right after I graduate — that sounded like the best choice to make."

Her teacher, Tina Epifani, says Charlotte's commitment to the field is evident every day.

"She gets along with all the students and teachers, hands in all her classwork and homework on time, excels on tests, follows directions, and asks questions when she needs to so she can master her skills," Epifani said.

She also has a wonderfully positive influence on the class. When Epifani asks students to list the things they are grateful for, "Charlotte" is a constant answer.

"As soon as she walks in the classroom, I can see how she brightens the other students' day with her smile and caring," Epifani said.

In addition to getting the technical skills she will need to be successful, Charlotte and her classmates learn important life skills related to their field, including communication strategies, listening skills and having a professional image.

"Charlotte gives her all in this course," Epifani said. "With the determination she puts forth in all areas of this class, I think she will continue to excel not only in this course but in her future career as well."
