## Career & Technical Education

New York State’s approval process for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs has raised the quality and rigor of courses that prepare students for employment and postsecondary study. Approved programs lead to an industry-recognized credential or certificate at the postsecondary level, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. CTE courses offer students the opportunity to apply academic concepts to real-world situations and prepare them for industry-based assessments or certifications. They have the opportunity to earn college credit or advanced standing while still in high school and take part in work-based learning opportunities where they demonstrate mastery of skills essential in the workplace. In addition, our Technically Endorsed programs, embedded in area businesses, have been recognized by *District Administration* magazine as one of more than 30 national innovative programs.

He is also thriving in the half-day Career & Technical Education (CTE) Computer Technology program, where his teacher recently praised him for doing exceptional work with Arduino programming and creating circuits. Finally, he is proving to be a leader at both Innovation Tech and in CTE. Jack recently attended the SkillsUSA Fall Leadership Conference in Albany so he could hone his skills as a chapter officer.

Kayla Beyer, his counselor at Innovation Tech, said Jack’s academic accomplishments are “nothing short of remarkable” and that “he always puts his best foot forward in all that he accomplishes.” Even more importantly, she said, Jack is a generous, kind-hearted young man who is always willing to help others.

“Jack is a steady source of light here at Innnovation Tech, and we can always count on him to be reliable, courteous and devoted to our program and his learning,” Beyer said.

When Jack started Innovation Tech as a sophomore, he knew it was a good choice. His hard work and excellent grades have landed him on high honor roll every quarter. He enjoys the school’s focus on Project Based Learning, which allows him to collaborate with his classmates, drive his own learning and do hands-on work with ties to community partners. He also loves the half-day Computer Tech program because it has long been his life’s ambition to work in the computer industry.
